Loose Ends from last study



☞ BEHOLD HE IS COMING WITH THE CLOUDS

☞ Is a prophecy

☞ Mt 24:30, Lk 21:27 and Rev 1:7a are speaking of the same prophecy

Matthew 24:30	Luke 21:27	Rev 1:7
30 And then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in the sky, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the SON OF MAN COMING ON THE CLOUDS OF THE SKY with power and great glory.	27 Then they will see THE SON OF MAN COMING IN A CLOUD with power and great glory.	7 BEHOLD, HE IS COMING WITH THE CLOUDS, and every eye will see Him, even those who pierced Him; and all the tribes of the earth will mourn over Him. So it is to be. Amen.

Loose Ends from last study



- ☞ Since we were able to tie Mt 24:30/Lk 21:27/Rev 1:7a as the same vision and prophecy, we learned that
 - ☞ The Sign of the Son of Man in the SKY coming with power and great glory is linked with Jesus coming with the CLOUDS
 - ☞ No one in the world is going to miss this monumental event
- ☞ BEHOLD HE IS COMING WITH THE CLOUDS will lead to the “Revelation” (unveiling) of Jesus Christ to the world!
- ☞ I want to clarify that the shaking of the heavens and JESUS COMING IN THE CLOUDS will not occur in a single moment
- ☞ I’d like to take a moment and show you...

Luke 21:25-28



☞ And for this I'd like to refer to Luke's account of the Olivet Discourse:

Luke 21:25-28

25 "There will be signs in sun and moon and stars, and on the earth dismay among nations, in perplexity at the roaring of the sea and the waves, 26 men fainting from fear and the expectation of the things which are coming upon the world; for the powers of the heavens will be shaken. 27 Then they will see THE SON OF MAN COMING IN A CLOUD with power and great glory. 28 But when these things begin to take place, straighten up and lift up your heads, because your redemption is drawing near."

Luke 21:25-28



- ☞ BEFORE the Son of Man comes in a cloud, the powers of the heavens will be shaken:
 - ☞ There will be signs in sun/moon/stars
 - ☞ Nations will be perplexed at the roaring of the sea and the waves
 - ☞ Men will literally faint from fear and the expectation of the things which are happening in space and on earth
- ☞ AFTER such things, then they (nations and men) will see THE SON OF MAN COMING IN A CLOUD with power and great glory
- ☞ Now I want to call our attention to v.28...

Luke 21:28



28 But when **these things** begin to take place, straighten up and lift up your heads, because your redemption is drawing near.”

✧ Allow me to fill in “these things” in context:

28 But when [you see signs in the sun (darkened), moon (blood red) stars (asteroids coming to earth) and when there are great tidal waves of epic proportions in the oceans (including the Great Mediterranean Sea) causing men to faint in dread and fear begin to take place, straighten up and lift up your heads, because your redemption is drawing near.”

✧ Now when Jesus says our “redemption is drawing near” this does not necessarily mean that our salvation is that very day or the next day

Luke 21:29-31



☞ Jesus then gives them the parable of the fig tree:

Luke 21:29-31

29 Then He told them a parable: “Behold the fig tree and all the trees; 30 as soon as they put forth leaves, you see it and know for yourselves that summer is now near. 31 So you also, when you see these things happening, recognize that the kingdom of God is near.

☞ A fig tree blooming tells us summer is near

☞ When the heavens are shaken (sun/moon/stars, roaring tidal waves and the earth is in dread), we are to recognize the kingdom of God is near!

☞ When these things happen, the KING OF KINGS is coming soon on the CLOUDS with great power and glory!

BEHOLD HE IS NOT COMING RIGHT AWAY



- From here, I'd like to point out that when the heavens begin to be shaken our redemption is near, but it's at least 3½ years away
 - I'd like to show this to you comparing the Seals and Trumpets vision
 - Remember:
 - JESUS IS NOT COMING WITH THE CLOUDS while the heavens are shaken
 - From Matthew/Luke, HE IS COMING WITH THE CLOUDS *AFTER* the heavens are shaken

6th Seal



☞ The heavens started to shake during the 6th Seal:

Revelation 6:12-17

12 I looked when He broke the sixth seal, and there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth made of hair, and the whole moon became like blood; 13 and the stars of the sky (astēr) fell to the earth, as a fig tree casts its unripe figs when shaken by a great wind. 14 The sky was split apart like a scroll when it is rolled up, and every mountain and island were moved out of their places. 15 Then the kings of the earth and the great men and the commanders and the rich and the strong and every slave and free man hid themselves in the caves and among the rocks of the mountains; 16 and they *said to the mountains and to the rocks, "Fall on us and hide us from the presence of Him who sits on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb; 17 for the great day of their wrath has come, and who is able to stand?"

7th Seal



☞ Fire was thrown from heaven to earth in the 7th Seal:

Revelation 8:4-5

4 And the smoke of the incense, with the prayers of the saints, went up before God out of the angel's hand. 5 Then the angel took the censer and filled it with the fire of the altar, and threw it to the earth; and there followed peals of thunder and sounds and flashes of lightning and an earthquake.

The heavens continued to be shaken during 1-4 Trumpets

1 st Trumpet	2 nd Trumpet	3 rd Trumpet	4 th Trumpet
<p>Revelation 8: 7 The first sounded, and there came hail and fire, mixed with blood, and they were thrown to the earth; and a third of the earth was burned up, and a third of the trees were burned up, and all the green grass was burned up.</p>	<p>Revelation 8: 8 The second angel sounded, and something like a great mountain burning with fire was thrown into the sea; and a third of the sea became blood, 9 and a third of the creatures which were in the sea and had life, died; and a third of the ships were destroyed.</p>	<p>Revelation 8: 10 The third angel sounded, and a great star fell from heaven, burning like a torch, and it fell on a third of the rivers and on the springs of waters. 11 The name of the star is called Wormwood; and a third of the waters became wormwood, and many men died from the waters, because they were made bitter.</p>	<p>Revelation 8: 12 The fourth angel sounded, and a third of the sun and a third of the moon and a third of the stars were struck, so that a third of them would be darkened and the day would not shine for a third of it, and the night in the same way.</p> <p>NOTE: This could help explain “no one knows the day or hour” comment. When the heavens are shaken and the sun/moon/stars are impacted, we might lose our ability to track days/hours</p>

5th Trumpet (1st Woe)



- ❧ The heavens weren't shaken in the same manner as 1-4 Trumpets
- ❧ But an angel was summoned and came from heaven to earth

Revelation 9:1-2

1 Then the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star from heaven which had fallen to the earth; and the key of the bottomless pit was given to him. 2 He opened the bottomless pit, and smoke went up out of the pit, like the smoke of a great furnace; and the sun and the air were darkened by the smoke of the pit.

- ❧ An angel (Abaddon, Apollyon) came from heaven to earth
- ❧ Smoke from the bottomless pit darkened the sun and the air

6th Trumpet (2nd Woe)



☞ More angels continued to be summoned

Revelation 9:13-15

13 Then the sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God, 14 one saying to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, “Release the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates.”

15 And the four angels, who had been prepared for the hour and day and month and year, were released, so that they would kill a third of mankind.

☞ IMPORTANT: The Two Witnesses arrive on the scene

☞ Prophesied for 1,260 days (3½ years)

☞ Ok so what can we take away from this?

6th Seal – 6th Trumpet



CASE IN POINT:

☞ There is at least a 3½ year gap between the 6th Seal & 6th Trumpet!

☞ **6th Seal:** The heavens began to shake

☞ **6th Trumpet (2nd Woe):** Two Witnesses arrive on the scene and their ministry lasted 3½ years before they were killed and raised

TRUTH: Jesus will return on CLOUDS sometime after the 6th Trumpet!

TRUTH: When the sun becomes black and the moon blood red, there will be at least 3 ½ years before Jesus returns ON THE CLOUDS with power and great glory!

Scripture Reading



Revelation 1:7 (NASB)

7 BEHOLD, HE IS COMING WITH THE CLOUDS, and every eye will see Him, even those who pierced Him; and all the tribes of the earth will mourn over Him. So it is to be. Amen.

Exposit Rev 1:7



7 BEHOLD, HE IS COMING WITH THE CLOUDS, and **every eye will see Him**, even those who pierced Him; and all the tribes of the earth will mourn over Him. So it is to be. Amen.

☞ We've covered the first part of v.7, now let's look at the remaining parts of verse 7:

☞ "every eye will see Him"

☞ "even those who pierced Him"

☞ "all the tribes of the earth will mourn over Him"

“every eye will see Him”



✧ I'd like for us to use Jesus's mock trial before the Sanhedrin as the basis to help us understand this phrase

Matthew 26

63 But Jesus kept silent. And the high priest said to Him, "I adjure You by the living God, that You tell us whether You are the Christ, the Son of God." 64 Jesus *said to him, "You have said it yourself; nevertheless I tell you, hereafter you will see THE SON OF MAN SITTING AT THE RIGHT HAND OF POWER, and COMING ON THE CLOUDS OF HEAVEN."

Mark 14

61 But He kept silent and did not answer. Again the high priest was questioning Him, and saying to Him, "Are You the Christ, the Son of the Blessed One?" 62 And Jesus said, "I am; and you shall see THE SON OF MAN SITTING AT THE RIGHT HAND OF POWER, and COMING WITH THE CLOUDS OF HEAVEN."

“every eye will see Him”



✧ I'd like to call to our attention what Jesus said to them

Matthew 26

63 But Jesus kept silent. And the high priest said to Him, “I adjure You by the living God, that You tell us whether You are the Christ, the Son of God.” 64 Jesus *said to him, “You have said it yourself; nevertheless I tell you, hereafter **you will see** THE SON OF MAN SITTING AT THE RIGHT HAND OF POWER, and COMING ON THE CLOUDS OF HEAVEN.”

Mark 14

61 But He kept silent and did not answer. Again the high priest was questioning Him, and saying to Him, “Are You the Christ, the Son of the Blessed One?” 62 And Jesus said, “I am; and **you shall see** THE SON OF MAN SITTING AT THE RIGHT HAND OF POWER, and COMING WITH THE CLOUDS OF HEAVEN.”

“every eye will see Him”



☞ “you will see” (Mt 26:74) and “you shall see” (Mk 14:62)

☞ Who’s “you”?

☞ Reconcile that with “every eye will see Him”

☞ REMEMBER:

☞ ROE #4 “Thou shalt interpret Scripture w/literal fulfillment”

☞ “every eye will see Him” means “every eye will see Him”!

☞ BUT WAIT A MINUTE, can’t this mean that it only applies to all who are on the earth at that time?

☞ REMEMBER:

☞ ROE #2 “Thou shalt not add or take away from Scripture”

“every eye will see Him”



☞ When Jesus was before the Sanhedrin and interrogated by the high priest, Jesus declared to them that He is the SON OF GOD!

☞ And to prove this, Jesus said they (the Sanhedrin) will see THE SON OF MAN SITTING AT THE RIGHT HAND OF POWER, and COMING ON THE CLOUDS OF HEAVEN

TRUTH: The high priest that year (Caiaphas) and the rest of the Sanhedrin (scribes, elders, chief priests) who condemned Jesus will all see with their own eyes JESUS SITTING ON THE RIGHT HAND OF POWER and COMING ON THE CLOUDS OF HEAVEN!

☞ In order for this to come to fruition, must mean what?... (don't peek)

“every eye will see Him”



☞ They must be resurrected!

TRUTH: There will be a resurrection to witness the return of JESUS!

☞ Does Revelation corroborate this? Oh you bet it does!

☞ After the 7th Trumpet is blown, John sees in his vision of 2 reapers

“every eye will see Him”



Revelation 14:14-16 (7th Trumpet: 1st Reaper)

14 Then I looked, and behold, a white cloud, and sitting on the cloud was one like a son of man, having a golden crown on His head and a sharp sickle in His hand. 15 And another angel came out of the temple, crying out with a loud voice to Him who sat on the cloud, “Put in your sickle and reap, for the hour to reap has come, because the harvest of the earth is ripe.” 16 Then He who sat on the cloud swung His sickle over the earth, and the earth was reaped.

☞ “son of man” = JESUS

☞ Here Jesus is doing the reaping... more on this in a future study

“every eye will see Him”



Revelation 14:17-20 (7th Trumpet: 2nd Reaper)

17 And another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven, and he also had a sharp sickle. 18 Then another angel, the one who has power over fire, came out from the altar; and he called with a loud voice to him who had the sharp sickle, saying, “ Put in your sharp sickle and gather the clusters from the vine of the earth, because her grapes are ripe.” 19 So the angel swung his sickle to the earth and gathered the clusters from the vine of the earth, and threw them into the great wine press of the wrath of God. 20 And the wine press was trodden outside the city, and blood came out from the wine press, up to the horses’ bridles, for a distance of two hundred miles.

“every eye will see Him”



- ✧ In Rev 14:14-20 (7th Trumpet), we have 2 reapers
 - ✧ The Son of Man with a golden crown on His head sitting on a white cloud with a sharp sickle and reaped the earth because it was ripe
 - ✧ Again more on this in a future study
 - ✧ Another angel came out of the Temple in heaven also had a sharp sickle gathered clusters and
 - ✧ Threw them into a great wine press of the wrath of God
 - ✧ This occurred outside the city (of Jerusalem)
 - ✧ Blood filled the streets (about 5ft high, spanning 200 miles)

“every eye will see Him”



TRUTH: Resurrections will occur after the 7th Trumpet is blown!

☞ It will be a mass resurrection unto life and judgment!

John 5:25-29

25 Truly, truly, I say to you, an hour is coming and now is, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God, and those who hear will live. 26 For just as the Father has life in Himself, even so He gave to the Son also to have life in Himself; 27 and He gave Him authority to execute judgment, because He is the Son of Man. 28 Do not marvel at this; for an hour is coming, in which ***all who are in the tombs** will hear His voice, 29 and will come forth; **those who did the good deeds to a resurrection of life, those who committed the evil deeds to a resurrection of judgment.**

☞ * “all who are in the tomb” in Jn 5:28 means what?

“every eye will see Him”



TRUTH: All in tombs (grave) up to that point will be raised!

☞ All who died between Adam - 7th Trumpet

TRUTH: This would include the Sanhedrin (Caiaphas and gang) who committed evil deeds will participate in the resurrection of judgment! And they along with the rest who practiced evil deeds since Adam will be raised to experience the wrath of God and witness the Revelation of JESUS CHRIST COMING WITH THE CLOUDS IN POWER AND GREAT GLORY!

TRUTH: JESUS WILL COME WITH THE CLOUDS when the 7th Trumpet is blown (last Great trumpet)!

“every eye will see Him”



So when John says BEHOLD HE IS COMING WITH THE CLOUDS and every eye will see Him it means EXACTLY what it says!

“even those who pierced Him”



- ✧ With that understanding it should be easier for us to understand this phrase
- ✧ Who is responsible for piercing (and killing) Jesus? (DON'T PEEK)

“even those who pierced Him”



Let's have Peter answer that:

Acts 2:22-24 (Peter's great sermon during Pentecost)

22 “**Men of Israel**, listen to these words: Jesus the Nazarene, a man attested to you by God with miracles and wonders and signs which God [the Father] performed through Him in your midst, just as you yourselves know – 23 this Man [Jesus], delivered over by the predetermined plan and foreknowledge of God [the Father], **you nailed to a cross by the hands of godless men [the Romans] and put Him to death.** 24 But God [the Father] raised Him [Jesus the Son] up again, putting an end to the agony of death, since it was impossible for Him [the Son of God] to be held in its power.

“even those who pierced Him”



- ✧ There are several parties involved in piercing Jesus
- ✧ The people of Israel is most responsible for killing Jesus
- ✧ Doesn't end there
 - ✧ Pilate was responsible for condemning Him (an innocent Man)
 - ✧ The Roman guards were responsible for beating, scourging and nailing Him (an innocent Man) to the cross, and piercing His side to ensure He was dead
- ✧ The Father planned and allowed all this
- ✧ Ok so what does “even those who pierced Him” mean?
- ✧ It means “those who literally pierced Him”! Which means...

“even those who pierced Him”



TRUTH: Those involved in crucifying Jesus too will see with their own eyes THE SON OF MAN COMING ON THE CLOUDS WITH POWER AND GREAT GLORY!

- ✧ Pilate, the men of Israel and Romans in Jesus's Day, will be resurrected and part of the group characterized by doing evil deeds and be part of the resurrection of judgment!
- ✧ They will be part of those in the tombs (graves) who will be raised spoken of in Jn 5:28-29 after the 7th Trumpet is blown!
- ✧ With this in mind, let's look at a familiar passage to us all...

“even those who pierced Him”



Matthew 23:37-39 (Jesus laments over Jerusalem)

37 “Jerusalem, Jerusalem, who kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to her! How often I wanted to gather your children together, the way a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, and you were unwilling.
38 Behold, your house is being left to you desolate! 39 For I say **to you**, from now on **you will not see Me until you say**, ‘BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD!’”

- ☞ “you” in the immediate context is the men of Israel in Jesus’s day!
- ☞ These along with others who do evil deeds will see Jesus with their own eyes and exclaim “BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD!”
- ☞ Is this not what the apostle Paul proclaimed in Philippians chapter 2...

“even those who pierced Him”



Philippians 2:9-11

For this reason also, God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name (onoma) which is above every name (onoma), 10 so that at the name (onoma) of Jesus EVERY KNEE WILL BOW, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, 11 and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord (kurios), to the glory of God the Father.

☞ “EVERY KNEE WILL BOW” means who?

☞ Those “under the earth” will be raised in the mass resurrection after the 7th trumpet (both the righteous and unrighteous)!

“even those who pierced Him”



- ☞ So when John says BEHOLD HE IS COMING WITH THE CLOUDS and every eye will see Him, **even those who pierced Him** again it means EXACTLY what it says!
- ☞ The men of Israel in Jesus's day who refused to repent and believe, and instead, plotted for His death, Pilate, and the Romans who carried out the crucifixion will be raised to experience God's wrath as they see JESUS COMING ON THE CLOUDS with great power and glory!

“all the tribes of the earth will mourn”



- ☞ By now, need I even ask what this means?
- ☞ But let's examine this anyhow
- ☞ “tribes” is phulē and it can also mean clan.
- ☞ The context tells us if it is referring to the tribes of Israel or the earth
- ☞ Here is an example

Matthew 19

28 And Jesus said to them, “Truly I say to you, that you who have followed Me, in the regeneration when the Son of Man will sit on His glorious throne, you also shall sit upon twelve thrones, judging the **twelve tribes (phulē)** of Israel.

Matthew 24 (Rev 1:7)

30 And then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in the sky, and then **all the tribes (phulē) of the earth** will mourn, and they will see the SON OF MAN COMING ON THE CLOUDS OF THE SKY with power and great glory.

“all the tribes of the earth will mourn”



- ❧ Although tribes (phulē) generally refers to Israel, because it does says earth broadly and not Israel or twelve or any other unique designation, I believe this means precisely what it says
- ❧ All tribes of the earth (Israel and Gentiles) will mourn (koptō)
- ❧ koptō is a very intense time of mourning or lament
 - ❧ It often includes striking or beating one's breast, wailing and crying
- ❧ The Bible time and time again warns that such a day is coming
 - ❧ The day of the LORD
 - ❧ The great Day
 - ❧ The great and awesome day of the LORD
 - ❧ The day of the LORD's wrath

“all the tribes of the earth will mourn”



Joel 1:15

15 Alas for the day!

For **the day of the LORD** is near,

And it will come as **destruction** from the Almighty.

Joel 2:11

1 The LORD utters His voice before His army;

Surely His camp is very great,

For strong is he who carries out His word.

The day of the LORD is indeed **great and very awesome,**

And who can endure it?.

“all the tribes of the earth will mourn”



Joel 2:30-31

30 “I will display wonders in the sky and on the earth,
Blood, fire and columns of smoke.

31 “The sun will be turned into darkness
And the moon into blood

Before **the great and awesome day of the LORD** comes.

Joel 3:14-15

4 Multitudes, multitudes in the valley of decision!
For **the day of the LORD** is near **in the valley of decision.**

15 The sun and moon grow dark
And the stars lose their brightness.

“all the tribes of the earth will mourn”



Zephaniah 1:14-18

14 Near is **the great day of the LORD**, Near and coming very quickly;
Listen, **the day of the LORD!** In it the warrior cries out bitterly.

15 A day of wrath is that day, A day of trouble and distress,
A day of destruction and desolation, A day of darkness and gloom,
A day of clouds and thick darkness, 16 A day of trumpet and battle cry
Against the fortified cities And the high corner towers.

17 **I will bring distress on men** So that they will walk like the blind,
Because they have sinned against the LORD; And their blood will be
poured out like dust And their flesh like dung.

“all the tribes of the earth will mourn”



18 Neither their silver nor their gold
Will be able to deliver them On **the day of the LORD'S wrath**;
And all the earth will be devoured In the fire of His jealousy,
For He will make a complete end, Indeed a terrifying one,
Of all the inhabitants of the earth.

☞ NOTE: associated with the 7 Bowls of Wrath judgments

☞ We'll look at one more... Obadiah...

“all the tribes of the earth will mourn”



Obadiah 1:15

15 “For **the day of the LORD** draws near on all the nations (including all tribes).

As you have done, it will be done to you.

***Your dealings will return on your own head.**

☞ ***Does this sound familiar? (DON'T PEAK)**

“all the tribes of the earth will mourn”



Matthew 27:24-26

24 When Pilate saw that he was accomplishing nothing, but rather that a riot was starting, he took water and washed his hands in front of the crowd, saying, “I am innocent of this Man’s blood; see to that yourselves.” 25 And all the people said, “**His blood shall be on us and on our children!**” 26 Then he released Barabbas for them; but after having Jesus scourged, he handed Him over to be crucified.

✧ TRUTH: the time will come when not only the men of Israel will look on Him on whom they have pierced, but the time will come when God takes vengeance on them and return their dealings on their own head!

“all the tribes of the earth will mourn”



- ☞ All this is to say, the prophecy is a time will come when all nations and tribes of the earth (Israel and Gentiles; resurrected and non resurrected) will mourn (koptō) in a very intense time of mourning or lament, including them striking or beating one's breast, wailing and crying
- ☞ This is precisely what the Bible time and time again warns that is in store in the future
 - ☞ The day of the LORD
 - ☞ The great Day
 - ☞ The great and awesome day of the LORD
 - ☞ The day of the LORD's wrath (up to and including the 7 Bowl Judgments)

In Closing



- ❧ As mentioned from our previous study JESUS COMING WITH THE CLOUDS means different things for different groups
- ❧ So also "every eye will see Him" also means different things to different groups:
 - ❧ Believers vs. unbelievers
 - ❧ Righteous vs. unrighteous
- ❧ So in closing I'd like to do something a little unique
- ❧ I'd like to do the Catarroja AMP of v.7, but one for each group

Catarroja AMP: Rev 1:7



Revelation 1:7 (to the **unbelieving**)

7 BEHOLD, THE SON OF MAN IS COMING WITH THE CLOUDS with great power and glory, and after the Great 7th Trumpet is blown, those who have died from Adam to that very day will be raised, those who did not repent and place their faith in the Son of God for forgiveness of their sins, but instead practiced evil deeds in unrighteousness will be raised to a resurrection of judgment, they along with Caiaphas, the scribes, the elders, the chief priests, the men of Israel, Pilate who condemned Jesus to death, the Roman guards who mocked, scourged, crucified, and pierced an innocent Man will all see JESUS COMING WITH THE CLOUDS with their very own eyes.

Catarroja AMP: Rev 1:7



These and the rest of the tribes of the earth will experience great trouble and distress, experience an intense time of mourning and lament, beating one's breast, wailing and crying over Him in that great and awesome day of the LORD comes. The men of Israel of Jesus's day will say BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD and they along with all who are raised will BOW their KNEES and proclaim JESUS IS LORD to the glory of God the Father. BEHOLD JESUS IS COMING WITH THE CLOUDS to bring punishment, wrath and eternal judgment for you. So it is to be. Amen.

Is this not what Paul's gospel declared?

Romans 2:1-11



Romans 2:1-11

1 Therefore you have no excuse, everyone of you who passes judgment, for in that which you judge another, you condemn yourself; for you who judge practice the same things. 2 And we know that the judgment of God rightly falls upon those who practice such things. 3 But do you suppose this, O man, when you pass judgment on those who practice such things and do the same yourself, that you will escape the judgment of God? 4 Or do you think lightly of the riches of His kindness and tolerance and patience, not knowing that the kindness of God leads you to repentance?

Those living in faith who remain at His coming will see JESUS COMING WITH THE CLOUDS and will not die, but instead will be changed in the twinkling of an eye and caught up together with the redeemed to meet the Lord in the air and forever be with the Lord.
