 3 O magnify the LORD with me, and let us exalt his name together.  
 4 I sought the LORD, and he heard me, and delivered me from all my fears. (mundane/ Servite, Initial, Filial)  
 5 They looked unto him, and were lightened: and their faces were not ashamed.  
 6 This poor man cried, and the LORD heard him, and saved him out of all his troubles. DAVID  
 7 The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that fear him, and delivereth them.  
 8 Taste and see that the LORD is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in him. Respect/Reverence
