Malachi 4:5-6 "Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD. ⁶And he will turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the hearts of the children to their fathers, lest I come and strike the earth with a curse."

Remembering the watching children will help you understand that:

- **Pride** must be deflated verse 18:4
- People must be valued verse 18:10
- **Problems** must be reconciled 18:15
- Pardon must be dispensed verse 18: 21-22, 35
- "Putting away," must be **put away**. 19:3-6
- **Prayer** must be a priority 19:13-15

Take this with you:

- Turning your hearts toward your children brings blessings.
- Turning your hearts away from your home **brings a curse**.
- Communicating how to handle the real life issues is more <u>caught by observation</u> than it is taught by education.
