- I. THE DIVINE PLAN IN THE BEGINNING
 - A. The work of God Creating the entire cosmos by, through and for Christ
 - B. The rest of God
 - 1. Creation ended; He stopped the work of creating
 - 2. Systems operating as created at peace
 - 3. Action stopped yet systems operate upheld by His Word
 - 4. Joyfully watching it all happen; refreshed
 - C. The image of God
 - 1. Representing God, in glory
 - 2. Ruling as He would rule
 - 3. Full direct communication with God
 - 4. United with God through His Spirit
 - D. The blessing of God: the work of man
 - 1. Fruitfulness
 - 2. Order from disorder
 - 3. Godly dominion over creation (not one another)
 - 4. To tend and keep the Garden
 - 5. The energy of God: Union with God through trust to image God in his work i.e. to glorify God
 - E. The distrust of God and its consequences
 - 1. Fruitfulness more difficult

 - A. The work of God
 - 1. The incarnation
 - 2. The ministry of Christ
 - 3. The crucifixion of Christ
 - 4. The resurrection of Christ
 - 5. The ascension of Christ
 - 6. To give rest to the people of God
 - B. The rest of God
 - 1. Jesus, the Christ, doing only the work of the Father w/o exertion—intentional submission
 - 2. "It is finished!"
 - 3. Seated at the Father's right hand waiting on the Father
 - C. The image of God: Born again through faith in the person and finished work of Christ; representing God; in union with God!
 - D. The blessing of God: the work of man
 - 1. Fruitfulness through abiding (resting)
 - 2. Ceasing from human works for righteousness
 - 3. Good works in Jesus' name through the Spirit
 - E. The energy of God
 - 1. Come unto me...and I will give you rest
 - 2. "Deny yourself, take up the cross and follow me"
 - 3. Abide in me; walk in the Spirit; be filled with the Spirit;
 - 4. Labor to enter that rest
