The Great Banquet: Parable of the Ambitious Guest (Luke 14:7-14) #1

It was a set up all the way. This dinner took place on the Sabbath day.

Jesus had reportedly violated the Sabbath on three separate occasions:

- i. Cast out demons & healed Peter's mother (Luke 4:31-41)
- ii. Healed a man with a withered hand (6:6-11)
- iii. Healed a bent over woman (13:10-17)

Furthermore, most conveniently, there was a man with dropsy at the meal

Religious leaders set a trap to for Jesus, but Jesus confounded them (3)

Jesus exposes their lovelessness & their thirst for position & power (4-6)
