# PCC WEEKLY PRAYER PLAN – May 13, 2020

## **Prayer application from Sunday's sermon, "[MARY, MARTHA, AND JESUS](#)"**

Luke 10:38-42 highlights our priority of spending time with the Lord.

- 1.) Taking time to be still in the presence of God is a significant spiritual discipline. Jesus prioritizes it over other duties in life.
  - a. What distracts you from taking time with God? Is He pointing out something during this quarantine that has been taking your time away from Him? Is he helping you rearrange your schedule to spend more time with him?
  - b. Do you have a special place where you go to spend time with the Lord? Is that place free of distraction?
- 2.) Sometimes, the issue isn't that we don't have time for the Lord. It's that we're hiding from him.
  - a. Is there something or some reason why you're disconnected with the Lord at this time? Is the Holy Spirit dealing with you about something you're not willing to change?
  - b. What will it take for you to come back into right standing with the Lord? How will you reprioritize your relationship with Him? *If you would like help with these questions, feel free to reach out to Pastor Dana or Pastor Chris.*

## **Pray about frustrations - government, social media, and divisiveness**

- 1.) Read II Chronicles 7:14. Humble yourself and pray with God. Reflect upon your perspective and ask for forgiveness accordingly. Gain the Lord's peace about the times and the role you play in His Church.
- 2.) Read 1 Timothy 2:1-4. Talk about and pray for government leaders in an uplifting way that pleases God.
- 3.) Read II Corinthians 10:4-5. The world fights on a political level. We pray for individuals not based on their human decisions, but based on the spiritual powers behind them.

## **Pray for neighbors**

- 1.) Read 1 John 5:19. Ask God to end the Devil's control over unsaved neighbors and loved ones.
- 2.) Read 2 Corinthians 4:3-4. Ask God to open your neighbor's eyes to the Gospel of Christ.
- 3.) Read 1 Corinthians 1:18. Ask God to help neighbors see and understand the message of the cross.

## **Pray for PCC congregation with various needs**

- 1.) Those that are in mourning
- 2.) Those with sicknesses in need of physical healing
- 3.) Neighbors that PCC members are reaching out to
- 4.) Peace and patience for all in hard family situations
- 5.) Employment for those needing finances
- 6.) Salvation for PCC streaming listeners who don't know the Lord
