

THE KING'S DISCIPLES

Matthew 28:16-20

Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. 17 And when they saw him they worshiped him, but some doubted. 18 And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

The more we look at our King, the more we understand who we are as his disciples.

1. Jesus' Disciples are Faithful but Messy.

Matthew 28:16-17

How can we best help each other as fallible and sometimes fragile disciples?

2. Jesus' Disciples are Faithful but Messy.

Matthew 28:18-20, Philippians 2:5-11, Genesis 18:18, Acts 11:18, 14:27, Revelation 20:1-3, Luke 10:17-19, Matthew 5:17-18, Ephesians 2:14-15.

Why is it important to see that the authority of Jesus is over both earth AND heaven?

How should you approach every command of Christ in the New Testament?

All believers are a holy and sanctified people, and that sanctification is a spiritual grace of the new covenant, and an effect of the love of God manifested in the soul, whereby the believer presseth after a heavenly and evangelical obedience to all the commands, which Christ as head and king in His new covenant hath prescribed to them. 1 Cor. 12; 1 Pet. 2:9; Eph. 1:4; 1 John 4:16; Matt. 28:20. First London Baptist Confession of Faith: Statement 29.

3. We make disciples of the King.

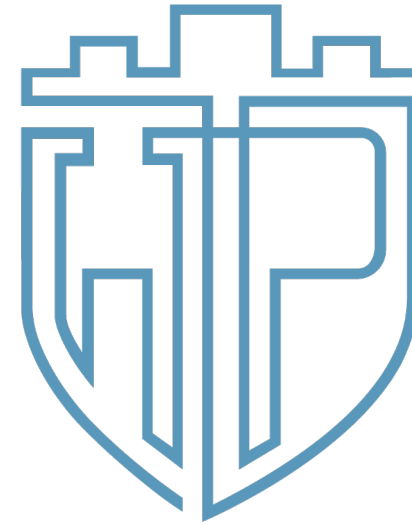
