- A. Companions "whose name was Hirah"

- C. Complacency "Er...wicked in the sight of the Lord"
- II. Justifying "And in process of time" (vs. 12-23)

Being acquitted because of:

- A. Loneliness "Judah's wife died"
- **B.** Loss "she was not given unto him to wife"
- C. Legality -"lest we be shamed"
- III. Judging "she is with child by whoredom" (vs. 24-30)

Being assumptive as to:

- A. Guiltiness "Bring her forth and let her be burnt"
- **B.** Goodness "She hath been more righteous than I"
- C. Greatness "his name was called Pharez"

Sentence Sermon:

"Spiritual contamination is anything that draws us away from a close relationship with God."
