## **2161 - HOSEA'S MINISTRY - 14:1-3**

INTRO. Hosea is about God marrying Israel – and Israel being extremely unfaithful to Him. Hosea is about God calling a young man in mid-twenties to be a prophet to Israel – his message is to assure Israel that they are welcome to return to God – Hosea has to make Israel realise God is full of forgiveness towards her. Hosea is a National call to repentance with individual application. There are two things that stand out in this book. (1) is that God really does love Israel! (2) is that God really wants Israel to know that He is 'all ready' to forgive them and have them back. God is commissioning Hosea to make sure that Israel gets His message, so that if Israel fails to respond to God's offer of forgiveness, they will never be able to say 'We were not sure if You really wanted us back'! Because God does want Israel back. If this Book does not apply to you, it will apply to someone you know!

\*Some Xns have a **problem** with this book. God telling Hosea to marry a prostitute? That is because they are treating God as if He were either a **machine** without feelings/emotions, or a human being with **unforgiving spirit.**! God **has** emotions! He is very **angry** with Israel. Anger may not be sinful! **Temper** is. Imagine a wife who knew her husband was being unfaithful away from home, at the club or at work - and she **wasn't bothered!** Did she really **love** her husband? What did **marriage mean** to her?

God's **anger** here is **not** over a domestic 'tiff' about whose turn it was to empty the dish-washer! Its over a **real/basic/divorceable** issue! Israel is **apathetic** about the 'agony **God** is going through' over Israel's unfaithfulness! God is in **pain** over what Israel has done, **adoring** false gods, spending **time/money/affections** on other gods! Israel does **not even notice** God's pain at this!

So God deciding to **shock** Israel! Nothing short of a **startling shock** will bring Israel to its senses. God **commands** Hosea *take to yourself a wife of whoredom* and have children of whoredom!! [1:2,3] So strange! God **does** ask His faithful servants to do **very strange** things at times! Isaiah to walk naked and barefoot for 3yrs [Isa 20:2,3] Ezekiel to lie on his left side for 390 days [Ez 4:4]!!

Why is Hosea to do this? To make a **picture**, a **visual aid**, of what **they** were doing to God! To **remind** Israel of **their** sin! Every time Hosea would walk down the street with Gomer, they would be reminded of their **incongruous** marriage to God! As soon as they would mutter and gasp at the couple 'What's **he** doing married to that type of woman', Hosea would reply that 'This is what **you** are doing to God – you are unfaithful to Him'!

In order for Hosea to be **genuine** in his appeals to Israel, he needs to **experience** what God Himself is experiencing – so God asks him to take a prostitute as a wife. Unless Hosea **experiences** God's pain, he will not be able to **express** the hurt/anger God is 'going through'! **APP** God really wants **you** to know that He hurts when you ignore His pleas for your **faithful love!** Are **you** spending **time** with God? **Do** you **daily** worship Him? How **often** to **you commend** Him to others? Do **you deny** yourself for Him?

\*Gomer was **unfaithful** to Hosea. The 1<sup>st</sup> child was Hosea's [1:3]. But the **other two** were **not**, they had **another father** – *Upon her children...I will have no mercy...because they are children of whoredom...she who conceived them has acted shamefully* [2:4] She was unfaithful **before** marrying Hos <u>and after</u> marrying him!

Despite Gomer's unfaithfulness, Hosea does **not divorce** her! God **hates** divorce! But she **leaves** Hosea and chases *her lovers*! [2:7a] But she does **not** settle down. She **doesn't** stay with them either and concludes *I will go and return to my first husband for it was better for me then, than now* [2:7b] She begins to realise that this jumping from bed to bed **doesn't** bring **security** – something she really needs! She didn't realise the good fellow she had. God says re Israel **she did not know** that it was **I** who gave her the **grain**, the **wine**, the **oil**, and who lavished on her silver and gold, which they used for **Baal** [2:8] God gave Israel everything they had!

<u>APP</u> This is one of the great sins of our day – our nation does **not acknowledge** God's **goodness** and **patience** with us. We think it is our 'cleverness' that brings us wealth! God is lavishing on us blessing after blessing which we are expending on false Baals. As a **nation** we are very well-off! A **large majority** of us have more

more than enough - that is because of God's goodness! **Failure** to acknowledge God's goodness to us is a great sin which offends God deeply! Do **you** actually **spend time** acknowledging God?

God now withdraws His help from backsliding Israel. And He waits to see if they will return! He longs to have them return to Him in penitence! the Lord waits to be gracious to you [Isa 30:18] So God says I will return again to My place, until they acknowledge their guilt and seek My face, and in their distress earnestly seek Me [5:15]! APP Those who are 'away' from God need to be reassured that God is waiting for them, 'waiting to be gracious to you' when you acknowledge your sin! - and repent!

\*God appeals again and again to Israel Return, O Israel, to the Lord your God, for you have stumbled because of your iniquity...I will heal their apostasy; I will love them freely, for My anger has turned from them [14:1,4]! As we mentioned, God wants a genuine repentance. There are so many insincere, counterfeit repentances! Even here Israel has an outward but not an inward repentance Come, let us return to the Lord; for He has torn us, that He may heal us; He has struck us down, and He will bind us up. After two days He will revive us; on the third day he will raise us up, that we may live before Him...let us press on to know the Lord...He will come to us as the showers, as the spring rains that water the earth' [6:1,3] But it is presumption - not repentance! It's not genuine! Because your love is like the morning mist, like the due that goes early away [6:4b] It does not last long!

Many people think that if they go to church, **that** will give them favour with God. If they keep showing their faces at the services, everything will be all right! It makes **them** 'feel' better! But no! God wants their **heart**! Unless the sin that keeps you from **commitment** to Christ is **fully confessed** and **repented** of, your sin is still before God! Look *they do not consider that I remember all their evil...their deeds surround them; they are before my face The pride of Israel testifies to his face; yet they do not return to the Lord their God [7:2,9,10] What was wrong with Israel was they were still going back and seeking solace/comfort from to their uncircumcised friends, Egypt/Assyria! They still had impro-*

**per relationships** with with those who did not know God! *calling to Egypt*, *going to Assyria* [7:11] <u>APP</u> Who do **you** seek comfort from? Where do **you** go when you need help?

Listen to God pleading for Israel: *I would redeem them, but they speak lies against Me. They do not cry to Me from the <u>heart</u>...they return but not upward [7:13c,16] + out of Egypt I called My son.

The more they were called, the more they went away [11:1,2]* 

<u>APP</u> Anyone here going further from the Lord? Do you know anyone **not attending** to their soul's salvation? Are you less **interested** in God and **praying less** than you used to do?

Well, God is in **agony** for Israel – and He is in agony for any of his covenanted people who are **estranged** from Him! He says about Israel *My people are bent on turning away from Me* [11:7] God is truly **serious** uninviting Israelite return to Him. *How can I give you up...How can I hand you over Israel?* [11:8]

So God now **spells out** for Israel what they must do! *Take with you words and return to the Lord, say to Him 'Take away all iniquity'...Assyria will not save us'* [14:2,3] He is saying turn to the Lord <u>in prayer and confession!</u> Admit your sin and <u>acknowledge</u> it before God. \*You know many people do not think the God of the OT is merciful! The God of the OT is a <u>Trinitarian God!</u> He is the very same God as in the NT! Six times we read of <u>God in Christ</u> in the NT! But God was 'in Christ' throughout the whole OT! That is why OT believers in God were saved/forgiven!

Confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved [Rom 10:9] Jesus said everyone who acknowledges Me before men, I also will acknowledge before My Father who is in heaven [Mat 10:32] APP Great lessons from this Book? (1) God is very jealous of His covenant people. He really does love them. He would rather send His sinless Son to suffer hell for them than allow them perish without hearing the gospel! (2) God really wants His servants not only to preach the gospel, but to make it very plain and clear, so no one will not miss the Good News!!
