No rain

1Ki 17:6 ...the ravens brought him bread and flesh in the morning, and...in the evening;

Handful of meal

1Ki 17:8 And the word of the LORD came unto him, saying,

1Ki 17:9 Arise, get thee to Zarephath...I have commanded a widow woman there to sustain thee.

1Ki 17:10 ...And when he came...he called to her, and said, Fetch me, I pray thee, a little water in a vessel, that I may drink.

- 1Ki 17:11 And as she was going to fetch *it*, he called to her, and said, Bring me, I pray thee, a morsel of bread in thine hand.
- 1Ki 17:12 And she said, *As* the LORD thy God liveth, I have not a cake, but an handful of meal in a barrel, and a little oil in a cruse: and, behold, I *am* gathering two sticks, that I may go in and dress it for me and my son, that we may eat it, and die.
- 1Ki 17:13 And Elijah said...Fear not; go *and* do as thou hast said: but make me thereof a little cake first, and bring *it* unto me, and after make for thee and for thy son.
- 1Ki 17:14 For thus saith the LORD God of Israel, The barrel of meal shall not waste, neither shall the cruse of oil fail, until the day *that* the LORD sendeth rain...
- 1Ki 17:15 And she went and did according to the saying of Elijah: and she, and he, and her house, did eat *many* days.
- 1Ki 17:16 *And* the barrel of meal wasted not, neither did the cruse of oil fail...

Widow's son raised

- 1Ki 17:17 ...after these things, *that* the son of the woman, the mistress of the house, fell sick; and his sickness was so sore, that there was no breath left in him.
- 1Ki 17:18 And she said unto Elijah, What have I to do with thee, O thou man of God? art thou come unto me to call my sin to remembrance, and to slay my son?
- 1Ki 17:19 And he said unto her, Give me thy son. And he took him out of her bosom, and carried him up into a loft, where he abode, and laid him upon his own bed.
- 1Ki 17:20 And he cried unto the LORD, and said, O LORD my God, hast thou also brought evil upon the widow with whom I sojourn, by slaying her son?
- 1Ki 17:21 ...he stretched himself upon the child three times, and cried unto the LORD, and said, O LORD my God, I pray thee, let this child's soul come into him again.
- 1Ki 17:22 And the LORD heard the voice of Elijah; and the soul of the child came into him again, and he revived.
- 1Ki 17:23 And Elijah took the child...and delivered him unto his mother...
- 1Ki 17:24 ...the woman said to Elijah, Now by this I know that thou *art* a man of God...

Sacrifice consumed

- 1Ki 18:19 ...gather to me all Israel unto mount Carmel, and the prophets of Baal four hundred and fifty, and the prophets of the groves four hundred...
- 1Ki 18:21 ...How long halt ye between two opinions? if the LORD *be* God, follow him: but if Baal, *then* follow him. And the people answered him not a word.
- 1Ki 18:33 ...Fill four barrels with water, and pour *it* on the burnt sacrifice...
- 1Ki 18:34 And he said, Do *it* the second time. And they did *it* the second time. And he said, Do *it* the third time. And they did *it* the third time.
- 1Ki 18:35 ...the water ran round about the altar; and he filled the trench also with water.
- 1Ki 18:38 Then the fire of the LORD fell, and consumed the burnt sacrifice, and the wood, and the stones, and the dust, and licked up the water that *was* in the trench.
- 1Ki 18:39 And when all the people saw *it*, they fell on their faces: and they said, The LORD, he *is* the God; the LORD, he *is* the God.

Rain

1Ki 18:41 And Elijah said unto Ahab...*there is* a sound of abundance of rain.

1Ki 18:42 ...Elijah went up to the top of Carmel; and he cast himself down upon the earth, and put his face between his knees,

1Ki 18:43 And said to his servant, Go up now, look toward the sea. And he went up, and looked, and said, *There is* nothing. And he said, Go again seven times.

1Ki 18:44 And it came to pass at the seventh time, that he said, Behold, there ariseth a little cloud out of the sea, like a man's hand...

1Ki 18:45 And it came to pass in the mean while, that the heaven was black with clouds and wind, and there was a great rain..

A 40 day/40 night journey on angel food

1Ki 19:4 But he himself went a day's journey into the wilderness, and came and sat down under a juniper tree: and he requested for himself that he might die...

1Ki 19:5 And as he lay and slept under a juniper tree, behold, then an angel touched him, and said unto him, Arise *and* eat.

1Ki 19:6 And he looked, and, behold, *there was* a cake baked on the coals, and a cruse of water at his head. And he did eat and drink, and laid him down again.

1Ki 19:7 And the angel of the LORD came again the second time, and touched him, and said, Arise *and* eat; because the journey *is* too great for thee.

1Ki 19:8 And he arose, and did eat and drink, and went in the strength of that meat forty days and forty nights unto Horeb the mount of God.

God's Still small voice

1Ki 19:9 And he came thither unto a cave, and lodged there; and, behold, the word of the LORD *came* to him, and he said unto him, What doest thou here, Elijah?

1Ki 19:10 And he said, I have been very jealous for the LORD God of hosts: for the children of Israel have forsaken thy covenant, thrown down thine altars, and slain thy prophets with the sword; and I, *even* I only, am left; and they seek my life...

1Ki 19:11 And he said, Go forth, and stand upon the mount before the LORD. And, behold, the LORD passed by, and a great and strong wind rent the mountains, and brake in pieces the rocks before the LORD; *but* the LORD *was* not in the wind: and after the wind an earthquake; *but* the LORD *was* not in the earthquake:

1Ki 19:12 And after the earthquake a fire; *but* the LORD *was* not in the fire: and after the fire a still small voice.

Captains consumed

2Ki 1:10 And Elijah answered...let fire come down from heaven, and consume thee and thy fifty. And there came down fire from heaven, and consumed him and his fifty.

Jordan River parted

2Ki 2:8 And Elijah took his mantle, and wrapped *it* together, and smote the waters, and they were divided hither and thither, so that they two went over on dry ground.

Elisha asked for a double portion of Elijah's spirit

2Ki 2:9 And it came to pass, when they were gone over, that Elijah said unto Elisha, Ask what I shall do for thee, before I be taken away from thee. And Elisha said, I pray thee, let a double portion of thy spirit be upon me.

Elijah taken into glory

2Ki 2:11 And it came to pass, as they still went on, and talked, that, behold, *there appeared* a chariot of fire, and horses of fire, and parted them both asunder; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven.

2Ki 2:12 And Elisha saw *it*, and he cried, My father, my father, the chariot of Israel, and the horsemen thereof. And he saw him no more: and he took hold of his own clothes, and rent them in two pieces.

Jordan River parted

2Ki 2:14 And he took the mantle of Elijah that fell from him, and smote the waters, and said, Where *is* the LORD God of Elijah? and when he also had smitten the waters, they parted hither and thither: and Elisha went over.

Water in ditches seen as blood

2Ki 3:16 And he said, Thus saith the LORD, Make this valley full of ditches...

2Ki 3:20 ...there came water by the way of Edom, and the country was filled with water.

Widow's oil multiplied

2Ki 4:2 And Elisha said unto her...what hast thou in the house? And she said, Thine handmaid hath not any thing in the house, save a pot of oil.

2Ki 4:3 Then he said, Go, borrow thee vessels abroad of all thy neighbours, *even* empty vessels; borrow not a few.

Shunamite widow's son raised

2Ki 4:32 ...when Elisha was come...behold, the child was dead, *and* laid upon his bed.

2Ki 4:35 Then he...went up, and stretched himself upon him: and the child sneezed seven times, and the child opened his eyes.

Poison pottage

2Ki 4:40 ...O *thou* man of God, *there is* death in the pot...

100 men fed

2Ki 4:43 ...should I set this before an hundred men? He said again, Give the people, that they may eat: for thus saith the LORD, They shall eat, and shall leave *thereof*.

Naaman cured of leprosy

2Ki 5:10 ...Go and wash in Jordan seven times...and thou shalt be clean.

Axe head swims

2Ki 6:6 And the man of God said, Where fell it? And he shewed him the place. And he cut down a stick, and cast *it* in thither; and the iron did swim.

King of Syria's army smitten

2Ki 6:17 And Elisha prayed, and said, LORD, I pray thee, open his eyes, that he may see. And the LORD opened the eyes of the young man; and he saw: and, behold, the mountain *was* full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha.

Deliverance from Syrians

2Ki 6:25 ...behold, they besieged it, until an ass's head was *sold* for fourscore *pieces* of silver, and the fourth part of a cab of dove's dung for five *pieces* of silver.

2Ki 7:1 ...Elisha said...Thus saith the LORD, To morrow about this time *shall* a measure of fine flour *be sold* for a shekel, and two measures of barley for a shekel...

2Ki 7:6 ...the Lord...made...the Syrians to hear a noise of chariots, and a noise of horses...

Elisha's bones revive the dead

2Ki 13:14 Now Elisha was fallen sick of his sickness whereof he died. And Joash the king of Israel came down unto him, and wept over his face, and said, O my father, my father, the chariot of Israel, and the horsemen thereof.

2Ki 13:20 And Elisha died, and they buried him. And the bands of the Moabites invaded the land at the coming in of the year.

2Ki 13:21 And it came to pass, as they were burying a man, that, behold, they spied a band *of men*; and they cast the man into the sepulchre of Elisha: and when the man was let down, and touched the bones of Elisha, he revived, and stood up on his feet.
