Main Thought: God's Word has the power to transform.

Sunday Outline:

- God's Word reveals new life in Christ (vs. 23)
 - Through faith in Christ
 - You are saved for eternity
 - You can live differently now
- God's Word endures forever (vs. 24-25)
 - Reasons we can trust in the enduring Word of God
 - Faithfully Recorded
 - Reliably Transmitted
 - Consistent Message
 - Continually Tested

- Who did you reach out to encourage this last week? What did you do and how did it go?

Discussion Starter: (*Suggested Time 5 minutes*)

- Share a Bible verse or passage that has impacted you during a challenging time?

Sermon Review: (*Suggested Time 20 minutes*).

Read 1 Peter 1:22-2:3 and discuss the following questions.

- Why is it encouraging to know that our faith in Christ and eternal security is based on God's Word?
- Of the four reasons shared that we can trust in the enduring Word of God, which is most impactful to you and why?
- Why do we find it so hard to long for God's Word like a baby longs for milk?
- What impact should God's Word have our daily lives?



Digging Deeper: *(Suggested Time 15 minutes)*

Read Joshua 1:1-9 and discuss the following questions.

- Why could Joshua be strong and courageous?
- Besides His presence, what else did God give Joshua to strengthen him?
- What was Joshua suppose to do with God's Word?
- What impact did God promise if Joshua did those things?

Application: *(Suggested Time 10 minutes)*

- Have you received the new life God's Word reveals? You can be saved for eternity and to live differently now.
- Because God's Word endures forever, you can trust it in every area of your life. Find a promise that speaks to what you are experiencing right now that you can write out and put somewhere where you will see it each day.
- Ask God what area in your life He wants to transform through the power of His Word.
