Rearing Moses Exodus 2:1-10

- 1. What kind of mom does it take to rear great kids?
 - It takes an ordinary mom <u>naturally</u> (vs.1-2a)
 - Being a mother is a blessing Proverbs 31:28 Her children rise up and call her blessed; Her husband also, and he praises her:
 - Being a mother is a bonus
 Psalm 127:3 Behold, children are a heritage from the Lord, The fruit of the womb is a reward.
 - It takes an ordinary mom with <u>natural affection</u> (v. 2b)
 2 Timothy 3:1-4 (KJV) This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.
 ²For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, ³Without natural affection, ... lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God...
 - Every mom should see her children as <u>special</u>
 - Every mom should seek to keep her children safe
 - It takes an ordinary mom with <u>unnatural perception</u> (v. 2b)
 - She recognizes evil influences Proverbs 13:20 He who walks with wise *men* will be wise, But the companion of fools will be destroyed.
 - She <u>teaches</u> right from wrong. Proverbs 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go, And when he is old he will not depart from it.
 - It takes an ordinary mom with <u>supernatural faith</u> (vs. 3-10)
 - She knows her <u>limits</u>
 - She knows her <u>Lord</u>
 - She knows her <u>legacy</u>
- 2. How important is it to rear good children?
 - Hey mom, you are not just rearing children you are training the next generation at child rearing.
