Focus Text: Acts 6:8-15. What is the significance of Stephen performing signs and wonders? How did some men respond to Stephen's ministry in verse 9? Describe Stephen's capabilities as noted in verse 10. From verse 10-14 what "Plan B" did Stephen's opponents implement after arguing with him failed? What's up with Stephen's appearance in verse 15? Please also read all of Acts chapters 6-7 which are closely related. The bulk of this section records Stephen's defense of the gospel.
