who - Apostle Paul

when ~ 66 AD, while temple was still standing

why - to explain Christ' present ministry, in heaven

cf: Wilmington, p 515

what -

Bible review: The Bible is a 'Christ centered' book.

OT is preparation for his life

Gospels are a manifestation of his life

Acts is the propagation of his life

Paul's epistles are the explanation of his life

Hebrews is the glorification of his life

where - Written to the Hebrews from Italy by Timothy

- sent to Jerusalem (and synagogues)

- cf Heb 3:1

how - Thematically: to show the immeasurable superiority of Christ Paul reasons that Christianity excels Judaism because of Christ The superlative glory of the Son of God ('sevens')

Christ is superior over: 1. the prophets, 1:1-3

2. the angels, 1:4-2:18

3. Moses, ch 3

4. Joshua, ch 4

5. Aaron, ch 5-6

6. the saints, ch 11

7. OT Judaism, ch 7-10

two divisions: doctrinal 1:1 - 10:18

practical 10:19 - end

The center of Judaism was the temple and the Levitical priesthood. Paul shows them the pre-eminence of the priesthood of Christ.

The Jews are encouraged to give up their earthly temple, human priesthood, physical altar and animal sacrifices ...because in Christ 'we have'...the great High Priest, the true altar, the one sacrifice, and true access into the very presence of the Most Holy.

## In closing --- Hebrews 13:22

Paul calls this book ... the word of exhortation .... i.e. 'warnings' ie. - 'pay attention'...'take head to what God says'...'listen up'
