

How can the believer handle and conquer such persecution when he is so unjustly treated?





1. Be Armed

It is dying to self, denying oneself, ceasing from sin (v.1).


¹ Forasmuch then as Christ hath suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves likewise with the same mind: for he that hath suffered in the flesh hath ceased from sin.; KJV

Our Goal in the Christian Life.






2. Be Aimed v. 2

It is doing God's will for the rest of one's days (v.2).

² That he no longer should live the rest of his time in the flesh to the lusts of men, but to the will of God. KJV





3. Be Adamant v.3-6

It is being fed up with sin, knowing that one has sinned enough (v.3).

3 For the time past of our life may suffice us to have wrought the will of the Gentiles, when we walked in lasciviousness, lusts, excess of wine, revellings, banquetings, and abominable idolatries: KJV



It is bearing the strange look by the world (v.4-5).

4 herein they think it strange that ye run not with them to the same excess of riot, speaking evil of you: KJV

5 Who shall give account to him that is ready to judge the quick and the dead. KJV



It is following the example of those gone before (v.6).

6 For for this cause was the gospel preached also to them that are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but live according to God in the spiritKJV



How can we handle and conquer all the trials and sufferings of this life?





4. Be Agreeable V.7-11

Live seriously, soberly, watching and praying (v.7).

7 But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober and watch unto prayer. KJV



Live with fervent love (v.8).

8 And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins. KJV



Live showing hospitality and do it ungrudgingly (v.9).

9 Use hospitality one to another without grudging. KJV



Live using your gift (v.10-11).

10 As every man hath received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

11 If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God; if any man minister, let him do it as of the ability which God giveth: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. Amen. KJV
