

# LITURGY FOR THE PUBLIC WORSHIP OF GOD


As we gather to worship this morning, take a moment to reflect on this important historical event as a way to prepare for an encounter with the living God.

## WORD ON WORSHIP

Pentecost Sunday

Today, Christians around the world are celebrating Pentecost Sunday. This day recalls Jesus' promise to send the Holy Spirit (John 14:16), which we see realized in the account in Acts 2. Jesus' promise came at a particularly tense moment, the night before his crucifixion when he was comforting his disciples. They were troubled, confused and even doubting that they knew the way to the Father. To reassure them, Jesus reminded them of who he was, and he promised them the Third Person of the Trinity. God is constantly giving. In Genesis, he breathed life into us and gave us the world to take care of and each other to love. To right a world we stewarded poorly, he gave us his One and Only Son, Jesus Christ. This month we mark his generosity in giving us the Spirit of truth. John Chrysostom, Archbishop of Constantinople in the 4th century, said, "God has given us the greatest gift possible and in profusion... What is this gift? It is the Holy Spirit!" Romans 8:32 says, "He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?" God has been unceasing and extravagant in his gifts to us. And they're not over yet! At the end of the Bible we see that he gives his chosen people a new garden-city to replace the one from which we were banished.

If the fully restored City of God is our destination, of which we are already citizens (Phil. 3:20), and if God has already given both his Son as an atoning sacrifice and his Spirit to guide us, what more do we need? We are freed up to discern by the Spirit what our neighbors' needs are and meet them proactively. We are strengthened by the Spirit to do so unceasingly, even as our flesh fails us. And we are given the fruit of the Spirit to give out of love rather than out of pride or guilt. From Acts 2:42 on, we see believers loving one another and the community around them as a result of the Holy Spirit's coming. Truly, God always gives more than we can even imagine.



God always comes to us before we can come to Him'. Biblical worship is a response to God's gracious revelation of Himself, calling us to worship.

# THE SACRAMENT OF HOLY COMMUNION

Communion—also known as the Lord’s Supper—has always been a common, shared, joyous family meal. This meal is for those who have placed their faith in Jesus Christ; for those Baptized Christians who trust in His once-for-all sacrificial death upon the cross for their salvation. When we celebrate this feast, we commune with the risen Lord Jesus who stands as our host to offer spiritual nourishment, renewal and life. We also commune with one another, participating together in the reconciling grace of God.

We warmly welcome to the table all who trust in Jesus and who have publicly professed their faith as members of a Christian congregation. At New City, we ask our children not to take communion until they have met with the elders to share of their faith in Christ, although all children are invited to come forward to receive a blessing and a word of encouragement. If you are not a Christian, we encourage you to spend this time reflecting on the prayers below in the hopes that a relationship with Jesus and membership in His Church may be considered.

You will be directed to make your way to one of the four stations in our sanctuary where you will receive the prepackaged cup containing wine and a wafer (gluten-free and grape juice available). Please take it back to your place so we can partake together.

### **GENERAL HOUSEKEEPING:**

The three building entrances open on Sundays will be the mains doors off of the Parking Lot, the southside entrance with elevator access, and the Sanctuary doors off of Pinecrest.





## HOW TO SCAN QR CODES?

QR Codes allow smartphone users to quickly access a web link without having to type a URL.

For most iPhone users, this technology is integrated into your camera app. Simply hover over the QR code using your camera app and wait for a pop-up notification that will open your web browser for you.

For older iPhone models and most Android phones, download the *Quick Scan* app to scan the codes.
