I. RESTORATION IS THE WILL OF GOD!


A. Restoration is to bring things back in to their proper, God-intended place and condition

- 1. It implies things are NOT in their proper place
- 2. It is explicit in its use in both the Tanakh and in the New Testament. Used over 950 times
- B. Restoration is God's law when things were out of the place He had intended for them
- C. Restoration has two parts to it.
 - 1. To bring something back to its <u>original</u> place
 - 2. To return it to its proper condition
- D. Restoration has a human side and a divine side
 - 1. <u>Repentance</u> is restoration of a soul to its position before God. This is the human side of restoration
 - 2. The divine side is God putting a human soul back in a relationship with Himself: justify
- E. Jesus illustrated His power to restore on many occasions with people whose physical condition had been altered by disease or malady
- F. Restoration is the future ministry of <u>Elijah</u>!
- G. The restoration of <u>Israel</u> is God's promise to then
- H. Restoration is what God has done for us!
- I. Restoration of the whole cosmos is what God has planned! We are a part of that beautiful plan of God!

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- *II. WORKING TOGETHER AS A COMMUNITY TO RESTORE THINGS IS GOD'S WILL!*
 - A. The church's establishment after Pentecost was restoration through the free movement of the Spirit of God in believer's lives. This freedom of <u>community sharing</u> illustrated what the restored kingdom of God would look like
 - B. This "networking" is the sharing of what each has to create the best situation for restoration. This networking is acknowledging that there is something bigger than life that needs our sacrifice to accomplish; something that is God's will
 - C. This networking for restoration is seen in this biblical admonition of Galatians 6:1: restoring a brother overtaken in a fault
 - 1. "Brethren" appeals to the <u>relationship</u> God created for us; this is a family thing
 - 2. "overtaken" implies we know one another well enough to know when one is out of place
 - 3. "ye who are spiritual" Plural not singular; involves those who are walking in the Spirit not the flesh; work together, there will be more than one need
 - 4. "restore" put him back together again; mend him; set the broken thing back to its intended working condition. Set the <u>bone</u>, do the <u>therapy</u>
 - 5. "in a spirit of meekness" not drill instructors but brothers/sisters who know themselves



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
