**TEXT: PROVERBS 14:7 TITLE: Who Are Your Friends?** 

→ Great Method to Reading Proverbs:

Read the chapter matching the day of the month.

In a month's time, we would work our way through the book, as 7/12 months have 31 days and Proverbs has 31 chapters.

→ Questions to Ponder:

"Who are your friends?"
"Who are the friends who shape your thinking?"
"Who are those in whom you confide?"

- → New Testament background principles:
- → 1 Corinthians 5:6—a little sin affects a lot of people.

  (Leaven = yeast, works its way through the whole batch of dough!) The whole Corinthian Church was affected by the gross sin of one member.
- → 1 Corinthians 15:33—<u>evil company defiles good</u> ethics.
- → Now, consider this from Proverbs:
- → *Proverbs* 12:26—wise choices in friendships are vital!
- → Proverbs 13:20—wisdom chooses wise friends!
- \*\*\* Wise believers will avoid certain bad influences:
- 1. A F\_\_\_\_\_ Person
  - → Proverbs 14:7

→ What are markers of folly in people?

The Hebrew word **cesiyl (בְּסִיל)** means "stupid fellow, dullard, fool" and it occurs 49 times in the book of Proverbs.
