Heidelberg Catechism, Questions 46-47 & 49-51

What do we mean by speaking of Christ's ascension to heaven?

That Christ, while his disciples watched, was taken up from the earth into heaven and remains there on our behalf until he comes again to judge the living and the dead.

But isn't Christ with us until the end of the world as he promised?

Christ is true man and true God. In his human nature Christ is not now on earth; but in his divinity, majesty, grace, and Spirit he is never absent from us.

How does Christ's ascension benefit us?

First, he is our advocate in heaven in the presence of his Father. Second, we have our own flesh in heaven as a sure pledge that Christ our head will also take us, his members, up to himself. Third, he sends his Spirit to us on earth as a corresponding pledge. By the Spirit's power we seek not earthly things but the things above where Christ is, sitting at God's right hand.

What does Scripture mean in telling us Jesus is at the right hand of God?

Christ ascended to heaven, there to show that he is head of his church, the one through whom the Father governs all things, so that through his Holy Spirit he pours out gifts from heaven upon us his members, and by his power defends us and preserves us from all enemies.


