Holy Living (Part 1): Money, Marriage and Brotherly Love

Hebrews 13:1-6

- **I. BROTHERLY LOVE** (1-3; Jn 13:34-35; 1 Jn 3:14)—We are family.
 - **A.** <u>Practice Hospitality</u> (2)—to welcome, entertain and provide for guests, visitors or strangers
 - **1.** <u>A Christian Virtue</u> (Rom 12:13 &n 16:23; 1 Tim 3:2 & 5:10; Tit 1:8; 1 Pet 4:9; 3 Jn 1:8)
 - 2. A Big Extended Family (Heb 2:11-17)—believers you don't know
 - **3.** <u>A Possibility of Entertaining Angels</u> (Gen 18:1-21 & 19:1-3; **Heb 1:14 & 12:22**; Rev 22:9)—fellow servants with us
 - B. Remember the Persecuted (3)—those being mistreated or in prison
 - **1. Awareness** (Phil 2:4)—Remember, think about, keep conscious
 - **2. Empathy** (1 Cor 12:26)—solidarity (unity, common interest, mutual support)
 - 3. <u>Action</u> (Mat 25:37-40; **Heb 11:24-25**)—practical ministry
- II. MARRIAGE (4)—A holy life is faithful and sexually pure.
 - **A.** <u>Honor Marriage</u> ()—respect, hold it in high esteem, do not violate covenant
 - **B.** <u>Sexual Purity</u> (Heb 12:15-16; 1 Jn 3:4)—God's Law reserves sexual relations *exclusively* for marriage, and within those bonds He *blesses* sex.
 - 1. Holiness demands sacrifice. (Rom 12:1)—Jesus is worth it!
 - **2.** Christians may be holy in marriage or in celibacy. (Mat 19:1-10) Maintain sexual purity both outside and inside of marriage.
 - a. Fornication is sexual immorality outside marriage
 - b. Adultery is sexual immorality inside marriage—breaking covenant
 - 3. The Law of God is for our good. (1 Jn 3:4)—sin harms us and others
 - **C.** <u>God's Judgment</u> ()—Fear of God should regulate *every* part of life, *including* sexual behavior.
 - 1. He has a right to judge. (Gen 1-2)—AUTHORITY as the AUTHOR

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- a. God <u>created</u> <u>us</u>.—our souls and bodies
- b. God designed sex.—it is good
- **c.** God <u>instituted</u> <u>marriage</u>.—exclusive, life-long relationship between one man and one woman (as long as both live)
 - > For mutual help, bonding and babies, to demonstrate the love of God (Eph 5:32)
- **2.** He <u>will</u> judge us. Every person will give account to Jesus for his or her own life and behavior.
 - a. How we treat each other in marriage—love and serve
 - b. Our <u>sexual behavior</u> inside and outside of marriage
- **3. Jesus <u>forgives</u> and <u>redeems</u> the repentant.** (Jn 8:11; Rom 6:-12; 1 Cor 6:9-11; 1 Jn 3:6;)—from sin, to righteousness
- **III. MONEY** (5-6; Ps 118:6; 1 Tim 6:6-10, 17-19)—A holy life is free from the love of money.
 - **A.** <u>Freedom</u> ()—Who is your master?
 - 1. Love of money is a root of all kinds of evil. (1 Tim 6:10)
 - 2. You cannot serve two masters. (Mat 6:24)—God or Money
 - B. Contentment ()
 - **1. A Christian Virtue** (Lk 3:12-14; 1 Tim 6:6,8)
 - **2.** Satisfaction with God (Ps 16:5-6, 9, 11)
 - C. Confidence (Mat 6:31-32; 1 Tim 6:17-19)—kingdom cannot be shaken
 - **1.** Fear is a diagnostic indicator of worship. (Isa 57:11; Ps 62:5-8 & 118:6)—"In God We Trust"
 - 2. Greed is a type of idolatry. (Col 3:5)— "In Money We Trust"
 - **3.** <u>Faith assures us we have an unshakable kingdom</u>. (Heb 10:34-45 &12:27-28)—more and better; the best is yet to come
 - 4. God is with us. (Deut 31:6; Mat 28:20; Rom 8:35-39)—right now & forever
