

# **HUMILIATION PRECEDES RECONCILIATION**

## **PHILIPPIANS 3:1-16**

We are a proud race...humanity

Contrast God's view of pride - Proverbs 8:13; 15:25; 26:12; Jeremiah 50:31; Matthew 23:12; Galatians 6:3; James 4:6 (1 Peter 5:5)

***There is one vice of which no man in the world is free, which everyone in the world loathes when he sees it in someone else, and which hardly any people except Christians ever imagine that they are guilty of themselves. ... There is no fault that makes a man more unpopular, no fault which we are more conscious of in ourselves. And the more we have it in ourselves, the more we dislike it in others. **Reminder:** Christianity is about total dependence. That is a foreign concept to us (by nature). We have such a difficult time releasing control of our lives to God. The pathway to the blessings of God in Christ is through the valley of humiliation.

*Humility is produced in us when we acknowledge and agree with the reality of our condition in light of God's holiness and our sinfulness.*

**The essence of pride is contending for supremacy with God, and lifting up our hearts against Him. ~ C.J. Mahaney** (The end goal of all pride is self-glorification.)

By placing all our trust in Christ it removes any grounds for human pride or boasting

#### 4. Paul's exhortation to rest in the finished work of Christ alone – v.8-11


#### 5. Paul's prompt to remember that we are in process – v.12-16
