TEXT: 1 Corinthians 11:13 Judge in yourselves: is it comely that a woman pray unto God uncovered?
14 Doth not even nature itself teach you, that, if a man have long hair, it is a shame unto him?
15 But if a woman have long hair, it is a glory to her: for her hair is given her for a covering.
16 But if any man seem to be contentious, we have no such custom, neither the churches of God.

"According to Roman law women were under the complete control of the *pater familias*, the male head of the extended family unit. This power extended to life and death. A death penalty could be imposed upon a woman for adultery or drinking alcohol [i.e., A. Gellius, Attic Nights X, 23, citing Cato. Cited in Lefkowitz-Fant]..."

11 For it hath been declared unto me of you, my brethren, by them which are of the house of Chloe, that there are **contentions** among you.
