## **Principles**

- Why are we devoted to God's Word?
  - o Is 40:8; cf Matt 24:35, Ps 119:105, 2 Tim 3:16-17, James 1:21
- God's Word is what people need
  - o Proverbs 30:5-6

# Studying the Word

- 1. Understand the Details
  - Define the passage (cf Acts 9, Saul)
  - o What is the context?
  - O What doctrines are involved?
  - o Define/understand difficult words, phrases, places, important people
  - o What resources are you going to use?
- 2. Determine the main point
  - o What is God communicating?
- 3. How does this relate to Christ?
  - o Luke 24:25-27, Luke 24:44
- 4. How would the Lord want this passage applied, lived out?

#### Communicate

- Does it matter to me?
- Communicate the main point

- Who is the audience?
- How much time do I have?
- What circumstances do I need to consider?
- How to organize? Simplify!
