Is divided into three parts: 1 Corinthians 15:20-25

Christ the First Fruits 1 Corinthians 15:20–23a, Matthew 27:50–54
 Happened between AD 33–27, fulfilled Leviticus 23:10–14
 Interval of time: Afterward=eperta, of undesignated duration. 1 Corinthians 15:23b

2. The Main Harvest 1 Corinthians 15:23b

Gathering the Main Harvest

A. The Changing—in the twinkling of an eye 1 Corinthians 15:51–57

B. The Comfort—concerning deceased believers 1 Thessalonians 4:13–18
This first stage of His coming is:
