Study in 1 Corinthians

- B. Their Bickering About Baptism 1 Corinthians 1:13-16
 - Who did Paul say he baptised? (v:13-16)

Consider the WHY, WHO, WHEN, WHERE, HOW and WHAT of Baptism.

16 years ago we had to 'earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.' Jude 3

At the heart of the issue was BAPTISM, The LORD'S SUPPER, and when the church started, known as 'Hyper-Dispensationalism', it teaches:

- The four gospels are entirely Jewish
- That Acts is largely Jewish and that the Jews were give a second chance to receive the kingdom.
- That the church didn't start till either Chapter 9, 13 or 28. Note: Ephesians 2:19-22
- That only Paul's writings are for the church
- That Peter's gospel is different to Paul's
- That Baptism and the Lord's Supper are not for the church
- That there are different ways of salvation in Old Testament, tribulation and millennium.

These heresies cause confusion and division within churches.
