The conditions of freedom - "If"

- 1. Freedom starts with an **event** (verse 30-31) **believe** (simple faith)
 - a. John 5:24 "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My word and <u>believes in Him</u> who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life.
- Freedom continues as a <u>relationship</u> (verse 31) <u>abide</u> (faithful following)
 - a. John 8:12 Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life."
- Freedom grows because of a <u>process</u> (verse 32) <u>revelation</u> (continual discovery)
 - a. John 1:17-18 For the law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. ¹⁸No one has seen God at any time. The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared Him.
- Freedom becomes reality because of <u>application</u> <u>obedience</u> (yes Lord)
 - a. John 8:51 Most assuredly, I say to you, if anyone keeps My word he shall never see death."
 - b. Romans 6:22 But now having been set free from sin, and having become slaves of God, you have your fruit to holiness, and the end, everlasting life.

How can I really be set free?

- Accept his free gift
- Abide in his word
- Acknowledge your sin

- Admit your bondage
- Act on his truth
 - Know it
 - o Apply it
 - o Obey it

John 8:32 And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." John 8:34 ³⁴ Jesus answered them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin. ³⁵ And a slave does not abide in the house forever, but a son abides forever. ³⁶ Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed.
