3. AN EXACTING CRY – 46a

- A. By His Crying So; He Exacted Fulfilled Prophecy. Psalm 22
- **B.** By Crying So; He Exacted (took on) God's Unrestrained Wrath Matt. 26v36v46 "But NOT as I will, But as You Will". God is judging sin. Romans 4v25 c.f.1 Cor.15v3;1 Peter 2v24; 1Peter3v18; 1 John 4:10; Gal. 3v3.
 - By Crying So; He Exacted Souls Of Sinful Men II Cor. 5v21 c.f. Jn 10v11; Isa 53v6; John 11v49-50; Gal 3v13; I Pt 2v24

4. AN EXALTED CRY -(46-50) C.f. Philippians. 2v5-11 READ:

- 1. THE SELF-GIVING DEATH v50. C.f. Jn 19v30 *tetelestai*. c.f. Luke 23v46; *John*. *10v18*; Isa. 53v10 12.
- 2. THE SAVIOR'S DEATH v51a c.f. Heb.9 & 10 epitomizes this reality.

APPLICATION & CONCLUSION:

- A. Dare not forget so great the salvation and evade all trends of lavished Ignorance of Christ' sacrifice for sin
- B. Dare Not be Indifferent toward what Christ has Done, for the privilege of peace with God, (reconciliation); Justification, salvation, sanctification & more importantly; for you maturity as you soldier on, on this Christ pilgrimage to Glory.
- C. REMEMBER (when faced with trials and temptation; know that:) Christ was in every way human, He is able to sympathize with us, despite the seasons the Lord, by His providence may allow. We must <u>imitate Christ</u>, trust in the Lord in such seasons, and focus our faith God, and be assured of divine help and support.
