This is a "Psalm of Re-orientation" - it's all prayer & all praise!

Background to Psalm 30

- Written by David
- The superscription/Title: for the Dedication at the House 2 Samuel 5-6. Interestingly, Jewish tradition offers many insights as to how Ps 30 was used. It may have been used at the feast of Hanukkah as the Talmud suggests (b. Sop 18b). There may have been some ceremony of "thanksgiving". Another Jewish source, the *Mishnah*, notes that Ps 30 was used at the feast of Firstfruits (*Bikkurim* 3.4; cf. Deut 26:1-11).
- a Psalm = to be sung with stringed instruments
- For the choir director (see Ps 31 heading which is really the last concluding phrase of Ps 30).

THESIS — in Psalm 30 - we see David totally given to praise & calling all to praise!

- I. REFLECT! = LOOK WHAT HAPPENED! (1-3) [declare]
- II. RECOUNT! = LET ME ITEMIZE IT ONE BY ONE! (4-12) [details]

NOTE! verses 4 & 12 = inclusio/sandwich structure (verbs: sing praise + give thanks)
