Luke 10:1-16 "In the Service of the Savior" May 26, 2013 OT: Ezekiel 28:1-10 Larry Yeager

Theme: We are sent out into the world as messengers of the Kingdom of God. We are promised both a plentiful harvest and great resistance. Those who receive the words of the messengers receive Jesus himself. Those who reject them will experience his judgment and wrath.

Background: Salvation that was far off – has come near in Jesus. Time is short – there are many places Jesus has not reached.

Introduction: A Disciple's True -

- **I. Identity** (We are closely identified with Jesus)
 - A. Laborers for the harvest
 - 1. 70 or 72?
 - 2. Going two by two
 - Matthew 18:16
 - 12 went out alone; now they go in pairs
 - 3. Preparing the way
 - Into the Trans-Jordan A neglected area.
 - Time is running out, need to "till" the fields
 - 4. Similar mission to the Twelve (4-9)
 - a. Let nothing slow you down!
 - b. Stay were "peace is there"
 - c. Offering the peace of salvation in Jesus!- Peace with God
 - B. Intimate identification with the Savior
 - Sent in His name, with His Word & authority.
 - 1. His WORD!
 - a. The savior's message is their message (16)
 - b. The Kingdom is come near! (11:20)
 - 2. His Power
 - C. Identified with His Kingdom
 - Truly are "ambassadors of Christ"

II. Danger

- A. Lambs among wolves?
 - 1. You will be vulnerable
 - 2. Wolves devour their prey
 - God will provide for/protect his sheep (Isaiah 40:11; 53:7)
- B. Rejection (Don't take it "personally")

III. Power

- A. Words of Life
 - 1. Peace comes to that "house"
 - 2. Fruitful labor -
 - Bountiful harvest
- B. Judgment! (12-16)
 - 1. Jesus rebukes James and John (9:55)
 - Not the place of the *messengers* to enforce eternal judgment.
 - 2. But Judgment will come.
 - Shake dust off feet in testimony against them
 - 3. More bearable for Sodom, Tyre, Sidon? (Romans 2:6-8)
 - Not judged because they didn't hear about Jesus or the gospel
 - 4. The message is a judgment!
 - 5. Greater judgment because of greater knowledge!

NOTE: What judgment are we heaping up for ourselves?

IV. Mission (Application)

- 1. To the ends of the Earth Mission hasn't changed.
 - -The messenger isn't the judge. God is.
- 2. Part of a long tradition
 - -You don't need a seminar to share the good news
- 3. Do you have that peace with God?
 - Do you have that *intimate* relationship with the Savior?
- 4. Truly a matter of life and death
 - We all deserve the just wrath of God
 - He has sent His only Son into the world
 - A narrow door to a vast Kingdom of Blessing
