Discussion Questions

The following questions are designed to be used by parents in discussing the sermon with their children, but can be used by anyone in discussing the sermon with others:

- 1. What stood out to you in this sermon? Why?
- 2. To whom does the Lord send Philip? Why does the Lord send Philip to him?
- 3. How was the Lord preparing this man to hear the good news about Jesus?
- 4. What did Isaiah 53 foretell?
- 5. What is the good news about Jesus?
- 6. What is baptism? What is the purpose of baptism?

Going Deeper:

These questions are designed for the believer to use in prayer with his/her Lord, and in discussion with brothers and sisters in the Lord:

- 1. How did this sermon challenge your thinking, or grow your understanding?
- 2. What does Isaiah 53 teach about the nature of Christ's death?
- 3. What sets biblical Christianity apart from all other religions?
- 4. Have you been baptized after believing in Christ? Why or why not? If you haven't been baptized, should you be baptized?
- 5. How can we apply this passage to personal evangelism?
- 6. What is the primary way you should be affected by this sermon this week?
