## **Leviticus 14:16, 18**

16 and dip his right finger in the oil that is in his left hand and *sprinkle some oil with his finger seven times before the Lord.* ... 18 And the <u>rest of the oil</u> that is in the priest's hand he shall *put on the head* of him who is to be cleansed. *Then* the priest shall *make atonement* for him before the Lord. (Cf. Lev. 4:26)

## **Key Idea for Israel**

When God heals a person's body so they can rejoin God's chosen people, this mercy and grace is paid for by the blood of a substitute provided for by God.

Furthermore, there is a true home God has prepared for His people that will be in His very presence.

# V. What does this Teach Us about the Ministry of Jesus?

- A. When Jesus "Heals" Us, We are Put on Display for a "Week"
- B. Jesus Pays Our Debt of Failure to Worship
  - 1. Sets us apart with his blood
  - 2. Anoints us with the Holy Spirit
- C. We are not Home Yet!
  - 1. When God heals physically...

#### Isaiah 53:4-5

<sup>4</sup> Surely he has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. <sup>5</sup> But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our *iniquities*; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and *with his wounds we are healed*.

When God chooses <u>not</u> to heal us physically...

## 2 Corinthians 4:16-18

<sup>16</sup> So we do not lose heart. Though *our outer self is wasting away*, our inner self is being renewed day by day. <sup>17</sup> For this light momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison, <sup>18</sup> as we look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen. For the things that are unseen are *transient*, but the things that are unseen are *eternal*.

3. When we get home to God, all signs of the curse will be no more!

## Revelation 21:3-4

<sup>3</sup> And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Behold, *the dwelling place of God is with man*. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and

God himself will be with them as their God. <sup>4</sup> He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away."

## **Key Idea**

The healing Jesus gives all his people is a deep, permanent healing from the corruption found in sinful hearts. This great salvation was paid for by the death of Jesus; was applied to us by our great High Priest when he anointed us with the Holy Spirit; and will ultimately include a new immortal body so that we will be fit for **His holy presence**.
