## Disciples of Christ: (5) Living in Humility

## I. Putting off Pride

- A. What is pride?
  - 1. Pride is a hunger for honor and thirst for glory.
  - 2. Pride is a great danger for those in positions of authority.
- B. Jesus calls us to put off this sinful, ugly pride.
  - 1. This is not the way of greatness in Christ's kingdom.
  - 2. Why?

## II. Putting on Humility

- A. Jesus is calling His disciples to be humble.
  - 1. Humility is the attitude of recognizing our insignificance and unworthiness before God.
  - 2. This humility is God's gift to His people.
- B. Let us consider a portrait of the truly humble person.
  - 1. A humble person is not greedy of honor that other people have but rejoices in the gifts God has given to myself and to others.
  - 2. A humble person does not try to call attention to self, but wants God to be glorified.
  - 3. A humble person is not mean toward others, but is kind and loving.
  - 4. A humble person is willing to receive biblical instruction, rebukes, and criticism. Prov. 9:7-9

## **III. Finding Greatness**

- A. We find greatness when we aren't thinking about greatness, but instead we think about humble service of others.
- B. We need to grow in this aspect of discipleship and the way to do this is to keep our eyes fixed on Jesus Christ and His life of service.
