BIBLE MIRACLES # 7, 6, 5 Physics and Life

#7 THE SUN STANDS STILL / GOES BACK 10 DEGREES

Jos 10:8 And the LORD said unto Joshua, Fear them not (5 kings): for I have delivered them into thine hand; there shall not a man of them stand before thee.

Jos 10:9 Joshua therefore came unto them suddenly, and went up from Gilgal all night.

- Jos 10:10 And the LORD discomfited them...and slew them with a great slaughter...and chased them along the way that goeth up to Bethhoron, and smote them...
- Jos 10:11 And it came to pass, as they fled...that the LORD cast down great stones from heaven upon them...and they died: they were more which died with hailstones than they whom the children of Israel slew with the sword.
- Jos 10:12 Then spake Joshua to the LORD...and he said in the sight of Israel, Sun, stand thou
- still upon Gibeon; and thou, Moon, in the valley of Ajalon.

 Jos 10:13 And the sun stood still, and the moon stayed, until the people had avenged themselves upon their enemies...So the sun stood still in the midst of heaven, and hasted not to go down about a whole day.
- Jos 10:14 And there was no day like that before it or after it, that the LORD hearkened unto the voice of a man: for the LORD fought for Israel.
- Isa 38:5 Go, and say to Hezekiah, Thus saith the LORD...I have heard thy prayer, I have seen thy tears: behold, I will add unto thy days fifteen years.
- Isa 38:6 And I will deliver thee and this city out of the hand of the king of Assyria...
 Isa 38:7 And this *shall be* a sign unto thee from the LORD, that the LORD will do this thing that he hath spoken;
- Isa 38:8 Behold, I will bring again the shadow of the degrees, which is gone down in the sun dial of Ahaz, ten degrees backward. So the sun returned ten degrees, by which degrees it was gone down.

#6 RESURRECTIONS TO NATURAL LIFE

Elijah and the widow's son

- 1Ki 17:17 And it came to pass after these things, that the son of the woman...fell sick; and his sickness was so sore, that there was no breath left in him.
- 1Ki 17:18 And she said unto Elijah, What have I to do with thee, O thou man of God? art thou come unto me to call my sin to remembrance, and to slay my son?
- 1Ki 17:19 And he said unto her, Give me thy son. And he took him out of her bosom, and carried him up into a loft, where he abode, and laid him upon his own bed.

 1Ki 17:20 And he cried unto the LORD, and said, O LORD my God, hast thou also brought
- evil upon the widow with whom I sojourn, by slaying her son?

 1Ki 17:21 And he stretched himself upon the child three times, and cried unto the LORD, and said, O LORD my God, I pray thee, let this child's soul come into him again.
- 1Ki 17:22 And the LORD heard the voice of Elijah; and the soul of the child came into him again, and he revived.

- 1Ki 17:23 And Elijah took the child, and brought him down out of the chamber into the house, and delivered him unto his mother: and Elijah said, See, thy son liveth.
- 1Ki 17:24 And the woman said to Elijah, Now by this I know that thou *art* a man of God, *and* that the word of the LORD in thy mouth *is* truth.

Elisha and the Shunamite woman's son

- 2Ki 4:16 And he said, About this season, according to the time of life, thou shalt embrace a son. And she said, Nay, my lord, *thou* man of God, do not lie unto thine handmaid.
- 2Ki 4:17 And the woman conceived, and bare a son at that season that Elisha had said unto her, according to the time of life.
- 2Ki 4:18 And when the child was grown...he went out to his father to the reapers.
- 2Ki 4:19 And he said unto his father, My head, my head...
- 2Ki 4:20 And when he had taken him, and brought him to his mother, he sat on her knees till noon, and *then* died.
- 2Ki 4:21 And she went up, and laid him on the bed of the man of God...and went out.
- 2Ki 4:22 ...and said, Send me...one of the asses, that I may run to the man of God...
- 2Ki 4:28 Then she said, Did I desire a son of my lord? did I not say, Do not deceive me?
- 2Ki 4:32 And when Elisha was come into the house, behold, the child was dead, *and* laid upon his bed.
- 2Ki 4:33 He went in therefore, and shut the door...and prayed unto the LORD.
- 2Ki 4:34 ...and he stretched himself upon the child; and the flesh of the child waxed warm.
- 2Ki 4:35 Then he returned, and walked in the house to and fro; and went up, and stretched himself upon him: and the child sneezed seven times, and the child opened his eyes.
- 2Ki 4:36 So he called her. And when she was come in unto him, he said, Take up thy son.

Jesus and the widow's only son

- Luk 7:12 Now when he came nigh to the gate of the city, behold, there was a dead man carried out, the only son of his mother, and she was a widow: and much people of the city was with her.
- Luk 7:13 And when the Lord saw her, he had compassion on her, and said unto her, Weep not.
- Luk 7:14 And he came and touched the bier: and they that bare *him* stood still. And he said, Young man, I say unto thee, Arise.
- Luk 7:15 And he that was dead sat up, and began to speak. And he delivered him to his mother.
- Luk 7:16 And there came a fear on all: and they glorified God, saying, That a great prophet is risen up among us; and, That God hath visited his people.
- Luk 7:17 And this rumour of him went forth throughout all Judaea, and throughout all the region round about.

Jesus and Jairus' daughter

- Luk 8:41 ...behold, there came a man named Jairus, and he was a ruler of the synagogue: and he fell down at Jesus' feet, and besought him that he would come into his house:
- Luk 8:42 For he had one only daughter, about twelve years of age, and she lay a dying. But as he went the people thronged him.

- Luk 8:49 ...there cometh one...Thy daughter is dead; trouble not the Master.
- Luk 8:50 But when Jesus heard *it*, he answered him, saying, Fear not: believe only, and she shall be made whole.
- Luk 8:51 And when he came into the house, he suffered no man to go in, save Peter, and James, and John, and the father and the mother of the maiden.
- Luk 8:52 And all wept, and bewailed her...he said, Weep not; she is not dead, but sleepeth.
- Luk 8:53 And they laughed him to scorn, knowing that she was dead.
- Luk 8:54 ...he put them all out, and took her by the hand, and called, saying, Maid, arise.
- Luk 8:55 And her spirit came again, and she arose straightway: and he commanded to give her meat.
- Luk 8:56 And her parents were astonished...

Jesus and 4-day-dead Lazarus

- Joh 11:1 Now a certain man was sick, named Lazarus...
- Joh 11:3 Therefore his sisters sent unto him, saying, Lord...he whom thou lovest is sick.
- Joh 11:5 Now Jesus loved Martha, and her sister, and Lazarus.
- Joh 11:6 When he had heard therefore that he was sick, he abode two days still in the same place where he was.
- Joh 11:7 Then after that saith he to his disciples, Let us go into Judaea again.
- Joh 11:11 ...Our friend Lazarus sleepeth; but I go, that I may awake him out of sleep.
- Joh 11:12 Then said his disciples, Lord, if he sleep, he shall do well...
- Joh 11:14 Then said Jesus unto them plainly, Lazarus is dead.
- Joh 11:17 ... when Jesus came, he found that he had *lain* in the grave four days already.
- Joh 11:21 Then said Martha...Lord, if thou hadst been here, my brother had not died...
- Joh 11:23 Jesus saith unto her, Thy brother shall rise again.
- Joh 11:24 Martha saith...I know that he shall rise again in the resurrection at the last day.
- Joh 11:25 Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:
- Joh 11:26 And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?
- Joh 11:32 Then when Mary was come where Jesus was, and saw him, she fell down at his feet, saying unto him, Lord, if thou hadst been here, my brother had not died.
- Joh 11:39 Jesus said, Take ye away the stone. Martha, the sister of him that was dead, saith unto him, Lord, by this time he stinketh: for he hath been *dead* four days.
- Joh 11:41 Then they took away the stone from the place where the dead was laid...
- Joh 11:43 And...he cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth.
- Joh 11:44 And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go.

Bodies after Jesus resurrection

Mat 27:52 And the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints which slept arose,

Mat 27:53 And came out of the graves after his resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many.

Peter and Tabitha (also called Dorcas)

Act 9:40 ...Peter put them all forth, and kneeled down, and prayed; and turning *him* to the body said, Tabitha, arise. ...she opened her eyes: and when she saw Peter, she sat up.

Paul and Eutychus

Act 20:9 And there sat in a window a certain young man named Eutychus, being fallen into a deep sleep: and as Paul was long preaching, he sunk down with sleep, and fell down from the third loft, and was taken up dead.

Act 20:10 And Paul went down, and fell on him, and embracing *him* said, Trouble not yourselves; for his life is in him.

Act 20:11 When he therefore was come up again...and talked a long while, even till break of day, so he departed.

Act 20:12 And they brought the young man alive, and were not a little comforted.

#5 ENOCH & ELIJAH TAKEN STRAIGHT TO HEAVEN

Gen 5:24 And Enoch walked with God: and he was not; for God took him.

2Ki 2:11 ...as they still went on, and talked... *there appeared* a chariot of fire, and horses of fire, and parted them both asunder; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven.

2Ki 2:12 And Elisha saw *it*, and he cried, My father, my father, the chariot of Israel, and the horsemen thereof. And he saw him no more...
