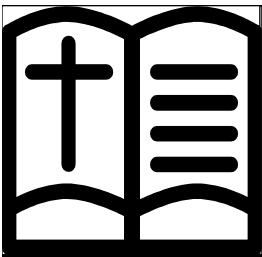
***PART 17: “A PRAYER ANSWERED”***

***I. PRAY WITHOUT CEASING: PRAYER IS SPIRITUAL WARFARE Daniel 10:1-10***

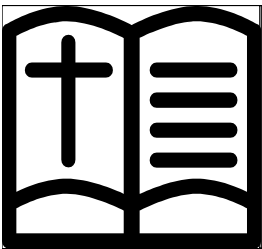
- A. The Torah is a land covenant for Israel; Daniel is old and he is living in exile away from the place of blessing!*
- B. Two years have passed since the decree to go back to Israel had been given; Daniel begins a fast, mourning that things are not going well in Israel*
- C. Daniel prays and fasts for 3 weeks without an answer;*
  - 1. Prayer is faith in action looking for answers to current dilemmas and for supernatural aid*
  - 2. God the eternal, self-existing, sovereign knows all that is going on at any instance of time*
  - 3. He is in control of the application of the content of the time*
  - 4. Our prayers are not heard by God alone.*
- D. When the answer comes, Daniel and his friends are overwhelmed by the messenger, but only Daniel sees him! (By the river: no synagogue)*

***II. WE WRESTLE NOT WITH FLESH AND BLOOD BUT WITH... Daniel 10:11-11:1***

- A. The answer to his prayer was delayed by a supernatural battle!*



- B. The whole earth is under the supernatural guidance of the sons of God and the hosts of angels who work with them. This is known as the divine council*
- 1. There is a “prince” for every nation, ethnic group and each prince effects the thoughts, worldviews, traditions and practices of the culture to which he is assigned*
  - 2. These were assigned at the division of nations at the tower of Babel.*
  - 3. God chose Israel as His own possession forever He gave them land, covenants, prophets, instruction, judgments, and promises*
  - 4. Michael the great archangel, was assigned to care for Israel, God’s people*
  - 5. When Daniel began his prayer to understand, he was instantly heard and the answer was dispatched.*
  - 6. But on the way, the messenger was halted by the prince of kingdom of Persia who did not want that message getting through to Daniel*
  - 7. Prayers may be hindered due to the content of that prayer. Remember: this is a seed against seed context! Israel is the object of hatred of all the forces of the rebellion, for through them the Messiah is coming!*
  - 8. Now that Messiah has come, Christians are also the target of destruction/elimination*
  - 9. Michael had to be called to aid him. Chapters 11 and 12 are the answer to his prayer*
