Luke 23:6-25

Bad decisions come when We succumb to:

I. Procrastination- “sent Him, sent Him again” (vs. 6-7)

Delay allows us to overlook our:

- A. **Principles** – “I find no fault”
- B. **Performance** – “I will ...release Him”
- C. **Priorities** – “as soon as he knew”

II. Pleasure - “seen some miracle done” (vs. 8-12)

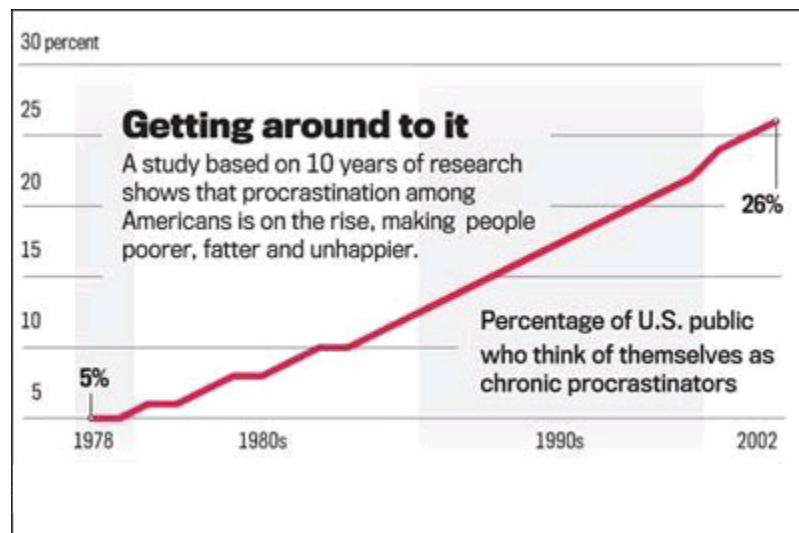
Hobbies may interfere with sound judgment by:

- A. **Anticipation** – “desirous to see Him”
- B. **Amusement** – “many words”
- C. **Affection** - “mocked Him”

III. Pressure - “to their will” (vs. 13-25)

Stress mishandled replaces sound judgment with:

- A. **Appeasement** – “chastise and release”
- B. **Accommodation** - “and he released unto them”
- C. **Abetment** – “he delivered Jesus to their will”
