**I. Doctrine: The “Betrothed” Corinthians—More Than Most**

**Bore The \_\_\_\_\_ of The Eschatological Crisis  
(of those days)**

A. –This Is Because they *May Have Had* their “\_\_\_\_\_”  
Up— . . . , (1 Cor. 7:26)

B. . . . —And Yet their *Dreams May Be Best Served Through*  
\_\_\_\_\_ (of them), (1 Cor. 7:28b)

The Whole Church, vv. 25-31**

A. –By *Alerting Everyone To The \_\_\_\_\_ Challenges of*  
*Life In Especially-Stressful Times*, vv. 25-28

B. –By *Giving Everyone A \_\_\_\_\_ That Hand-*  
*les Life In Especially-Stressful Times*, vv. 29-31a

C. –By *Preparing Everyone For The \_\_\_\_\_ World (in*  
*Christ), That Reigns Over Especially-Stressful Times*, v. 31b

**III. How Today’s Verses \_\_\_\_\_ To us—Now That we  
Are Well Into The Fullness of The New Covenant Era**

A. –Partly Through “\_\_\_\_\_” of Those Times, (*like*  
*a worldwide pandemic*), (1 Pet. 4:12)

B. –Partly Through our Necessary \_\_\_\_\_ In  
Christ, (no matter *what* difficulties we are facing), (Heb. 10:36)

**Key Verse**—v. 25: “*Now concerning the betrothed, I have no command from the Lord, but I give my judgment as one who by the Lord’s mercy is trustworthy.*” (ESV)
