

A Spotlight on Free Masonry



It's Beginnings

Founded in 1717 in England when several members of four lodges met at London's Goose and Gridiron Tavern to form the first grand lodge. The first Masonic Lodge was established in the U.S. in 1733.

Operative Free Masonry which goes back much further than the 1700's was similar to a carpenter's union where tradesmen formed unions for credibility and protection. However, speculative free masonry can be traced back to 1717 in London and 1733 in the United States.

It's Membership

You can only become a member of Freemasonry by recommendation from a lodge member It is restricted to males 21 years or older

Oaths & Rituals are required for earning different degrees

Every Mason enters through the Blue lodge and then has the opportunity to achieve 3 degrees (Entered Apprentice, Fellow Craft, and Master Mason) before choosing the York or Scottish Rite.

Leaders

Free masonry has never had 1 authoritative leader. Masons are led by the laws an regulations of free masonry itself. Each separate lodge elects its own officers. Yet, all lodges have the same symbols, degrees, and teachings. Key leaders in the past have included **Albert Mackey**, **Joseph Ford Newton**, **Henry Wilson Coil**, **Carl Claudy**, **H.L. Haywood**, and **Albert Pike**, all who have made significant contributions by their writings about Freemasonry.

Helping a Christian Out of Freemasonry/Witnessing to a Mason



Show him Freemasonry's view of ecumenical authority of many Bibles.

The Bible is affirmed, and even revered by the Masons, but no as the infallible and inerrant Holy Word of God. Scripture is nothing more than a symbol of the will of God. It is no more divine or inspired than any other "holy" book of other religions.

"By the very honor which Masonry pays to the Bible, it teaches us to revere every book of faith...joining hands with the man of Islam as he takes oath on the Koran, and with the Hindu as he makes covenant with God upon the book he loves best" (Joseph Fort Newton - *The Bible in Masonry - p. 5*)

Bible Verses to Share: 2 Timothy 3:16; 2 Peter 1:20-21; Joshua 23:6; 1 Thess. 2:13

Show him the confusion of ecumenism that Freemasonry promotes.

"If Freemasonry were simply a Christian institution, the Jew and the Moslem, the Brahman and Buddhist, could not conscientiously partake of its illumination." (Albert Mackey, Encyclopedia of Freemasonry, p.182.)

Show him Freemasonry's corrupt view of the doctrine of God.

"Monotheism... violates Masonic principles, for it required belief in a specific kind of Supreme Deity" Henry Wilson Coil. Coil's Masonic Encyclopedia, p. 517

God is most often referred to as the Great Architect of the Universe. That being said, they believe that "God is equally present with the pious Hindoo…the Jew…the Mohammedan.. And the Christian in the church" (Robert I Clegg, rev. Mackey's Revised Encyclopedia of Freemasonry, 1:409-10.)

Bible Verse to Share - Deuteronomy 6:4-5; Mark 12:28-30

Show him the Freemasonry's Corrupt View of Christ.

"It (Masonry) reverences all the great reformers. It sees in Moses, the Law giver of the Jews, In Confucius and Zoroaster, in Jesus of Nazareth, and the in the Arabian Iconoclast, Great Teachers of Morality and Eminent Reformers, if no more: and allows every brother of the Order to assign to each such higher and even Divine Characteristics as his Creed and Truth require" (Albert Pike – Morals and Dogma of the Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite of Freemasonry p. 525)

"God never manifested himself to be seen of men. Creation is his manifestation" (J.D. Buck – Symbolism or Mystic Masonry, p. 276)

Bible Verse to Share - John 1:14; Hebrews 1:1-3; 2 John 1:9; Ephesians 1:20-23

· Contrast freemasonry's belief that all religions lead to Heaven vs. Christ as the only way.

Bible Verse to Share - Matthew 7:22-23; Acts 4:12; John 14:6; 1 Timothy 2:5

 Contrast Freemasonry's view of coming out of darkness vs. the Bible's view of coming out of darkness.

"The Masonic Initiate has long been in darkness, and now seeks to be brought to light" Duncan, Malcom C. Masonic Ritual and Monitor, n.d., p. 29.

Bible Verse to Share - John 8:12; Col. 1:13; Acts 26:18

 Contrast Freemasonry's salvation through pure conduct with the Bible's view of salvation by grace alone.

"The lamb has in all ages been deemed an emblem of innocence. By the lambskin, therefore, the Mason is reminded of that purity of life and conduct which is so essential to his gaining admission to the Celestial Lodge above, where the Supreme Architect of the Universe presides." (Louisiana Masonic Monitor, pp. 44-45)

Perform the duties of your respective stations...and you will receive from your Almight Father an inheritance in corruptible, and undefiled, that fadeth not away – (*Tennessee Craftsmen or Masonic Textbook* – p. 126).
