## John 10:14-15

Introduction:

- 1. In John 10 Jesus warns against the danger of strangers...
- 2. He teaches the importance of being a sheep...
- 3. He speaks of Himself as the "Good Shepherd" a theme, which should have been very familiar to the people of Israel... see *Genesis 48:15 cf. Psalm 23:1 with Psalm 80:1-2*

**Consider** in preparation for the Lord's Supper two great things, which Jesus identifies about Himself—"The Good Shepherd..."

- I. He Knows His Own Sheep, vs. 14
- A. He knows our every need and weakness...
- B. We are prone to wander...
- C. Sinners who are saved by grace own and confess their shortcomings...

- A. He Actually died for us...
- B. It was a Voluntary and Sacrificial death...
