Westminster Confession of Faith 20.1 (Of Christian Liberty, and Liberty of Conscience)

God alone is Lord of the conscience,^a and hath left it free from the doctrines and commandments of men, which are, in any thing, contrary to His Word; or beside it, in matters of faith, or worship.^b So that, to believe such doctrines, or to obey such commands, out of conscience, is to betray true liberty of conscience:^c and the requiring of an implicit faith, and an absolute and blind obedience, is to destroy liberty of conscience, and reason also.^d
