Main Point:

Despite what sins you are struggling with, know that God can change you.

1. God can change you like Judah.

2. God can change you like Jacob.

3. God can change you like Joseph's brothers.

4. God uses outward pressures and His love to bring about this change in you.

Psalm 93:3-4 ³ The floods have lifted up, O LORD, The floods have lifted up their voice; The floods lift up their waves. [But] ⁴ The LORD on high *is* mightier Than the noise of many waters, *Than* the mighty waves of the sea. (NKJV)
