Main Point:

Since we need God to work among us, seek His power through corporate, constant, and believing prayer.

1. We need God to powerfully work among us.

2. This means we need to be committed to prayer.

3. Because God works through the prayers of His people.

4. Therefore, seek the Lord's power through corporate, constant, and believing prayer.
