Matthew 5:1-12

Introduction to the Sermon on the Mount. Perhaps a summary of 2-3 days of teaching (cf. 15:32). Matthew clusters 5 blocks of Words and 6 of Works. This is first of Words and is most definitive. And the first twelve verses (5:1-12) are key to understanding the rest of the sermon. Introduction to the Beatitudes: the summary of the Sermon. Celebrate Recovery is based on the 8 Blessings of 5:1-12. Four things to observe about the "Beatitudes" before we consider each one: I. Christ *wants* you to be That is a surprise to many.
