II. THE BEAUTY OF MOTHERHOOD FOR THE AGES OF THE EARTH

- A. Genders are only for this age and the intentions of God; there are only 2 genders; in their complement they are to be married to one another for the purpose of this age to be <u>fruitful</u> and <u>multiply</u>
- B. In the new earth, the kingdom, among the restored there will be no need for marriage or procreation Like all other promises of the kingdom, it awaits the fulfillment of the coming of Christ
- C. No eternal pregnancy motherhood is for the <u>present</u> age
- D. Motherhood reflects the intimate, compassionate, life-sustaining <u>nurture</u> of God. This glorifies God
- E. Sin, the perversion of love and trust, alters motherhood; we need Christ to restore us!
 - 1. <u>Resentment</u> of the role with its blood, its pain and its fruit
 - 2. Attempts to thwart it or destroy it
 - 3. Abuse of our offspring
 - 4. Abuse of sex
 - 5. Abuse of parents and the tragic outcome
 - 6. Distraction of our desires leads to neglect of our children's godly training; surrendering it to others with opposing agendas
 - 7. Deifying motherhood to the status of goddess
- F. Restored motherhood brings us all into a status of widening our love to include those that may not belong directly to us. We have been freed to love!
