God is my personal Father–“Our Father”

1. It is an intentional relationship
2. It is an intimate relationship

God is my powerful Father–“Which art in Heaven”

1. He Is Omniscient (Psalm 139:1-4)
2. He Is Omnipresent (Psalm 139:7; Jeremiah 23:24)
3. He Is Omnipotent (Jeremiah 32:17; Job 26:7; Psalm 115:3; Ephesians 3:20)

God is my praise worthy Father–“Hallowed be thy name.”

1. A. God's Name Reveals his righteousness (Psalm 20:7; Psalm 9:10)
2. God's Name Requires our reverence (Psalm 29:2; John 12:28)

But, Is God your Father?

- Galatians 3:26-27 For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. ²⁷For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.
- Matthew 11:27 All things have been delivered to Me by My Father, and no one knows the Son except the Father. Nor does anyone know the Father except the Son, and *the one* to whom the Son wills to reveal *Him*.
