- E. Identified by the Dignity of His Leadership position before the armies of heaven
- F. Identified by the Romphia of His mouth-Rev. 1:16; 19:15
- G. Identified by the allusions to Prophesies of Scripture-Ps. 2:9; Isa. 63:1-6 (Rev.19:13)

## III. HIS NAMES

- A. The Name that no man knows-Rev. 19:12
  - 1. The Name of His *Ontological Sonship* (Second Person of the Trinity)
  - 2. The Name, having been written
  - 3. No man knows -parallel to Rev. 2:17 (Manna and White Stone and New Name)
- B. His Name [is] The Word of God-Rev. 19:13
  - 1. Having been clothed in a garment-allusion to Matt. 27:31,35; John 19:23
  - 2. Dipped in (dyed in ) blood
  - 3. The Name of His *Messianic Sonship*
- C. His Name is Jesus, His Anthropic Sonship (Truly Man)
  - 1. Having been written
  - 2. A name written twice:once upon the garment;once upon the thigh (Gen. 24:2)
  - 3. King of Kings and Lord of Lords
    - a. Lord of Lords and King of Kings-Rev. 17:14; 1Tim. 6:15
    - b. The Arnion, The Lamb
    - c. At the Name of Jesus, Phil 2:10
