THE CHRISTOLOGY OF THE REVELATION:

I. REVELATION 19:10

- A. Translation: Worship God, for <u>The Witness</u> to Jesus is <u>The Spirit</u> of The Prophecy (*i.e. the source of the Prophecy is the Holy Spirit*)
- B. Rev. 19:10 is a summary of the Christology (i.e. teachings about Christ) of the Book of the Revelation and in essence is a summary of the teachings of all of Scripture about Jesus Christ.
 - 1. The Witness to Jesus in the Revelation is the conclusion of a century of revelation and meditation upon the Person and Work of Christ (the Scriptural teachings concerning Jesus Christ)
 - a. The Witness to Jesus in the Revelation is totally consistent with the witness of the Hebrew Scriptures (the Old Testament)-Luke 24:44,45
 - b. The Witness to Jesus in the Revelation is totally consistent with the witness of the Greek Scriptures (the New Testament)-1Tim. 3:15,16
 - 2. The Holy Spirit, Himself, takes great delight in revealing the Person and Work of Jesus Christ -John 16:14 "*He shall glorify Me; for He shall take of Mine, and shall disclose it [announce it]* to you.
 - a. Jesus possesses the unlimited authority of the Holy Spirit-John 3:34
 - b. Jesus bestows the Holy Spirit upon His disciples after His Ascension-Acts 1:8
 - c. Throughout the Revelation, the Spirit Himself bears witness to Jesus
 - (1) Grace and Peace from the Father and the Spirit and the Son-Rev. 1:4
 - (2) John was in the Spirit-Rev. 1:10; 4:2; 17:3; 21:10
 - (3) The Spirit addresses the Seven Churches-Rev. 2,3 (7 times)
 - (4) The Spirit summons men to salvation-Rev. 22:17
 - (5) The Images of the Spirit are found throughout the Revelation
 - (a) His Right Hand-Rev. 1:17
 - (b) The Seven Spirits of God-Rev. 5:6
 - (c) The River of the Water of Life-Rev. 22:1
 - (d) The Seal-Rev. 7:2

II. REVELATION 1:1-THE DISCLOSURE OF JESUS CHRIST

- A. Jesus Christ is the object of the disclosure-The Revelation is about Him
- B. Jesus Christ is the subject of the disclosure-The Revelation comes from Him
- C. This feature of the genitive explains a number of passages in the Revelation
 - 1. Rev. 1:7,8 (from Him and about Him)
 - 2. Rev. 22:16 *I*, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things for the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, the bright morning star."

III. THE SELF-DISCLOSURES OF JESUS (THE CHRISTOLOGY OF THE CHRIST)

- A. Rev. 1:8 I am the Alpha and the Omega," says the Lord God, "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty."
- B. Rev. 1:17,18 I am the First and the Last and the Living One
- C. Rev. 2:2 I know (oida)
- D. Rev. 22:7 I am coming quickly
- E. Rev. 22:13- "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End."
- F. Rev. 22:16- I, Jesus, have sent My angel
- G. Rev. 22:20-It is true. I am coming quickly

 - 4. The Lamb who possesses the Book of Life-Rev. 13:8
 - 5. The Lamb who reigns upon Mount Zion-Rev. 14:1
 - 6. The Lamb who is the object of our praise-Rev. 15:3
 - 7. The Lamb whose Bride is the Church-Rev. 19:7,9; 21:9
