- II. The Timing of The Call.
 - A. Solomon appeals to his wife, and motivates her to heed his call, by pointing out that it is spring.
 - B. In at least two ways, spring is a picture of the work of God's grace in us.
 - C. The timing of the call is instructive for husbands and wives.
- III. The Memory of The Call.
 - A. The Shulamite later recalls this event, seeing more clearly her husband's true love for her.
 - B. Later, the church remembers the true love of Christ for us in times past.
 - C. Later, the wife on earth sees more clearly that her husband's love was true and constant.
