Is Jesus Really Your Lord?

A. The BOAST without OBEDIENCE-- 6:46

- 1. Jesus is speaking to those who....
 - a. Have made some sort of Confession of faith
 - b. Are Celebrating their faith-- "Lord, Lord"
 - c. Are Exercising their faith-- Matthew 7:21-23
- 2. Jesus is speaking to Professing, not Possessing believers.
- 3. Is Jesus a mere "figure head" or "functioning head"?
- 4. Genuine followers of Jesus follow Jesus—Matthew 16:24-25

B. The BENEFIT of OBEDIENCE—6:47-49

- "Sure foundation for life that withstands future storms"
- 1. Illustration: Two Builders
 - a. Similarities
 - 1) Both hear Christ's Words
 - 2) Both build their lives after hearing God's Word
 - 3) Both build in the same location as indicated by storm
 - 4) Both build same kind of house above ground
 - b. Difference—Foundation
- 2. Application
 - a. You can build your house either on "sand" or on "rock"
 - 1) The "sand" of secular thinking and religious tradition
 - 2) The "rock" of Jesus Christ—1 Corinthians 3:11
 - b. Your foundation will be tested by life's storms.
 - 1) Examples of "life's storms"
 - 2) Those who build on sand will not survive.
 - 3) Those who build on the solid rock will endure.
 - c. Your foundation can be certified by God—2 Timothy 2:19
 - 1) Two-fold Seal of Approval
 - a) "The Lord knows those who are His"
 - b) "Those who confess Christ turn away from sin"
 - 2) Simply Stated: Trust and Obey
