Main Point:

Rejoice in your relationship with Jesus and enjoy the blessing of living it out.

1. You have life in Jesus because of your union with Him.

2. You get to see and know Jesus because of your life in Him.

3. You should always obey Jesus because of your love for Him.

4. You will be blessed by Jesus because of your obedience to Him.

Romans 6:9 9 ... Christ, having been raised from the dead, dies no more. Death no longer has dominion over Him. (NKJV)

Ephesians 2:4-5 4 But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, 5 even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ ... (NKJV)

1 Corinthians 15:17-18, 20-21 17 And if Christ is not risen, your faith *is* futile; you are still in your sins! 18 Then also those who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished ... 20 But now Christ is risen from the dead, *and* has become the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. 21 For since by man *came* death, by Man also *came* the resurrection of the dead. (NKJV)
