Proverbs 6:20 (KJV)

²⁰ My son, keep thy father's commandment, and forsake not the law of thy mother:

Proverbs 6:20 (TEV)

²⁰ Son, do what your father tells you and never forget what your mother taught you.

Proverbs 6:20 (NIV)

²⁰ My son, keep your father's commands and do not forsake your mother's teaching.



Proverbs 6:21 (KJV)

21 Bind them continually upon thine heart, *and* tie them about thy neck.

Proverbs 6:21 (TEV)

21 Keep their words with you always, locked in your heart.

Proverbs 6:21 (NIV)

21 Bind them upon your heart forever; fasten them around your neck.



Proverbs 6:22 (KJV)

22 When thou goest, it shall lead thee; when thou sleepest, it shall keep thee; and *when* thou awakest, it shall talk with thee.

Proverbs 6:22 (TEV)

22 Their teaching will lead you when you travel, protect you at night, and advise you during the day.

Proverbs 6:22 (NIV)

22 When you walk, they will guide you; when you sleep, they will watch over you; when you awake, they will speak to you.

²³ For the commandment *is* a lamp; and the law *is* light; and reproofs of instruction *are* the way of life:

²³ Their instructions are a shining light; their correction can teach you how to live.

²³ For these commands are a lamp, this teaching is a light, and the corrections of discipline are the way to life,
